We are pleased to inform you that the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters is organising **‘Scouts of World Award Discovery Workshop’ under Messengers of Peace** at the Bharat Scouts and Guides, Dr. Annie Besant Scout and Guide Training Centre, Doddaballapur, Bangaluru, Karnataka State from **04<sup>th</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> December, 2021.**

The Scouts of the World Award Discovery Workshop Programme will offer the young people i.e. Sr. Scouts & Sr. Guides and Rovers & Rangers an opportunity to acquire the knowledge, skills, and values needed to become an active citizen who can play an innovative role in making the world a better place, starting with the local community. The Scout of the World Award focuses on development, peace, and the environment in supporting community development, ending hunger, combating climate change, decreasing violence, protecting world heritage, and **what global issue do young people care most about, and which one does affect their local community?** The workshop will brainstorm to prepare and identify the global issues that the youth value and act upon them in their local community. <b>How to Reach</b>	<b>:</b>	Trains are available up to Bangalore. From Bangalore Railway Station walk towards Majestic Bus Station. From Majestic Bus Station, frequent Buses are available for Doddaballapur (Bangalore to Doddaballapur is approx. 40 K.M.). Get down at Doddaballapur Railway Station Bus Stop. From here, take Auto or Walk 1.5 K.M. to reach Dr. Annie Besant Scouts and Guides Training Centre. <b>For further assistance, contact Shri M. Prabhakara Bhat, SOC(S) Mobile No. 9448914540</b>
<b>What to Carry by the Participants</b>	<b>:</b>	One set of correct & complete Scout/Guide uniform as per A.P.R.O. Part-II & III, warm bedding/sleeping bag, bed-sheet, writing materials, personal medicines, if

		any, eating utensils, track-suit & sports shoes to undertake adventure activities, costumes for cultural programme, MOP T-Shirt/BSG T-Shirts, hand sanitizer and mask is mandatory. <b>NB: Participants above 18 years of age must be Covid Vaccinated and need to produce Certificate issued by the Government during the registration. Participants Under 18 year should produce RT-PCR Negative Test report taken 72 hours prior to departure for the workshop. This is mandatory. Without vaccination certificate or test report, participants will not be admitted in the workshop.</b>
<b>Eligibility for Participation</b>	:	Senior Scouts/Guides and Rovers/Rangers between the age 15-25 years of age at Least Rajya Puraskar/ Nipun Badge holder is eligible to participate. Preference may be given to Rashtrapati Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger.
<b>Quota Allocation</b>	:	<b>02 Rovers, 02 Rangers, Total= 04 from each State Association.</b> One Female unit Leader can be deputed to escort the Rangers. <b>Extra participants will not be accepted.</b>
<b>Registration Fee</b>	:	<b>180/- per head</b> is to be deposited during registration being the Scout/Guide Welfare Fund by each participant i.e. Scouts/Guides/Rovers/Rangers and <b>Rs 280/- per head</b> for Adult Leaders.
<b>Financial Support</b>	:	<b>Free Lodging &amp; Boarding during the workshop duration will be provided by the Bharat Scouts and Guides Karnataka State Association.</b>
<b>Last date of Registration</b>	:	The list of participating candidates duly recommended by the State Association should reach National Headquarters at <a href="mailto:internationaldesk@gmail.com">internationaldesk@gmail.com</a> with a copy to <a href="mailto:info@bsgkarnataka.org">info@bsgkarnataka.org</a> on or before <b>25<sup>th</sup> November, 2021</b> . If <b>State Association is not utilizing the allotted quota, please inform the National Headquarters so that additional quota can be allotted to host States.</b>
