06.	<b>Who can Participate</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- Open to all Male / Female age group 12-45 years.</li> <li>2- Members of Adventure Club, Youth Organization and members of Bharat Scouts and Guides.</li> <li>3- Medically and Physically fit and can bear the strain of Trekking for 12 K.M per day.</li> <li>4- One Escort must be deputed with a group of 8 to 15 Boys/ Girls.</li> <li>5- Lady Escort must be deputed with the female participants.</li> <li>6- Student without Escorting Teacher will not be allowed.</li> <li>7- Escorts should also Register and Pay the Full Camp Fee along with Application, Risk and Medical Certificate.</li> <li>8- The age limit for Escorting Teacher is 60 years (Male / Female)</li> </ol>
07.	<b>Programmes</b>	Trekking, Zip Line, Sky Cycling, Rock Climbing, Valley Crossing, Rappelling, Rifle Shooting, Archery, Obstacle Crossing, Boating, Night Hike, Nature Study, Camp Fire, Cultural Program, activities on Scouting/Guiding etc. <b>(Program may be changed without any notice as per the situation).</b>
08.	<b>Kits to Brings</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- T-Shirt, Jeans and Tracksuits, Extra wearing clothes and costumes for cultural items.</li> <li>2- One set correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part- II &amp; III. (For Uniform members only)</li> <li>3- Warm Clothes, Jackets, Sweeter, Hand Gloves (For winter only).</li> <li>4- Hunter/ Sport Shoes, Extra Pairs of Socks and Slippers, Plate (Thali) Glass or Mug, Spoon, Water Bottle.</li> <li>5- Personal Toiletries, Cold Cream, Odomas, Torch, Note book, Pen First Aid Kit Sleeping Bag/ Blankets.</li> <li>6- Masks and Sanitizers for daily use.</li> </ol>
09.	<b>Accommodation</b>	Tent for Participants and Escorting teachers at the campus of the Institute.
10.	<b>Weather</b>	During winter lowest temperature is around 02°C – 03°C and in summer maximum temperature is around 40°C. Carry sufficient warm clothing during winter.
11.	<b>How to reach</b>	The nearest Railway Station is <b>Pipariya</b> , which is one hour journey from <b>Itarsi Junction</b> towards Jabalpur and about 3 hours from Jabalpur towards Itarsi on Itarsi- Allahabad Railway Line. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi is 56 KM. Buses are available for Pachmarhi. From Pachmarhi bus stand to Institute is 05 KM. Local transportation is available.

12.	<b>Document to be submitted after arrival</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- One recent stamp size color photograph.</li> <li>2- Malaria Test report (Tested within a week before departure).</li> <li>3- Medical Fitness Certificate and Risk Certificate.</li> <li>4- Parent consent letter in case of minors.</li> <li>5- Copy of Aadhar card / Identify proof of Institution.</li> </ul>
13	<b>Risk Management</b>	The Bharat Scouts and Guides take every care of the participants sincerely, but The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Adventure Institute, Pachmarhi will not be held responsible for any accident, illness or injury during the program. The Escorting teachers should take extra care of their students before the camp, during the camp and after the camp.
14.	<b>Health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- Medical Check-up should be done strictly.</li> <li>2- Camp Doctor will provide medical assistance. General Medicines and First Aid will be available at the Institute. Extra medicines for individuals if any, will have to be purchased by the person concerned.</li> </ul>
15.	<b>Other Information's</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- Without selection letter, participants will not be admitted in the camp.</li> <li>2- Pachmarhi is a polythene free area. Hence no one should bring polythene bags with them.</li> </ul>
