SUB: Observation of World Environment Day-2021- An Online Art Competition

Dear Sir/Madam,

This World Environment Day, join #GenerationRestoration to revive and protect our ecosystems. The **theme** for **World Environment Day 2021** is **"Ecosystem Restoration"** **World Environment Day** is the United Nations day for encouraging worldwide awareness and action to protect our environment. Therefore, to commemorate and observe the importance of the day, the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters is organising an **"ART COMPETITION"** for the Cubs/Bulbuls, Scouts/Guides and Rovers/Rangers to engage themselves at home and take a step to observe the **'World Environment Day-2021'**

Aims & Objectives of the Competition:

1. To succeed in creating awareness amongst young people to comprehend in-depth the complexity of the looming dangers of uncontrolled climate devastation.
2. To acquire practical, put to usage skills, competency & attitude to confront the environmental challenges & their mitigation.
3. To encourage proactive & enthusiastic participation from the young people to create a "Green and safe planet".

Eligibility:

- Cubs & Bulbuls, Scouts & Guides, and Rovers & Rangers registered under The Bharat Scouts and Guides are eligible to take part in the competition.

Age Groups Categories

- 05-10 Years - Cubs/Bulbuls
- 11-16 Years: Scouts/ Guides
- 17-25 Years: Rovers/Rangers

Structure of the competition:

1. The competition will be held at 2 levels - **Regional level** (Entry round) & **National level** (Final round)
2. **Registration Fee: Rs 100/-** for each entry to be remitted in the below mentioned account details of the Bharat Scouts and Guides.

3. **The registration link** which includes submission of entries and uploading the Art is open. The link will close on **28th May, 2021 at 5.00 P.M. sharp.**

4. **Regional level results** will be declared live via BSG YouTube channel on **1st June, 2021 at 4.00 PM**
5. **Top 5 participants from each age group (Region wise) i.e. 5x3x6 = 90 participants** shall be declared qualified by the Panel of Judges for the Final round.
6. The final round competition will be held online via **zoom on 3rd June, 2021.** Timings are as under:
 - ❖ **10.00 A.M. to 01.00 P.M. for Cubs/Bulbuls**
 - ❖ **02.00 P.M. to 04.00 P.M. for Scouts/Guides**
 - ❖ **06.00 PM to 08.00 P.M. for Rovers/Rangers**
7. All finalists need to **submit their entries by Uploading two pictures - one selfie with drawing/art and one picture of your drawing/painting/art via google link** that will be provided. The link will be open only **for 20 minutes** after the zoom call ends.
8. Finals results will be declared on **5th June, 2021 during a virtual webinar to commemorate observation of "World Environment Day-2021".**

Methodology:

I. Regional Level Competition (Entry Round):

Theme: SDG Goal No. 13 "Climate Action" (10 marks: (8+2). Both the activities are mandatory)

a) What to do: **Best out of Waste- An Art (8 marks)**

- **Materials which can be used:** Plastic bottles, glass bottles, Styrofoam, aluminium cans, tin cans, aluminium foil, plastic straws, plastic wraps, Ziploc bags, plastic bags, nylon, cotton clothing/thread, leather shoes, wool clothing, disposable diapers, sanitary pads, rubber shoe soles, batteries, light bulbs, ink cartridges, Scrap metal, Painted/ treated wood, tires and basic stationary items like glue, scissors, old papers, colours, etc.
- Judging criteria: **4 marks for creativity + 4 marks for usability = 8 marks**

b) Selfie with a plant at home (2 marks)

c) Participants have to submit their entries by 28th May, 2021 by 5.00 P.M. as stated above.

II. National Competition (Final Round):

Theme: "Ecosystem Restoration" (10 marks: 5+5)

a) What to do: **Drawing/Painting (An Art competition)**

b) Criteria for judgement : Creativity (5 marks) & Message portrayed (5 marks)

Awards to the winners:

1) 3 best from each age groups will be selected by the Panel of Judges constituted at the National Level and awarded 1st, 2nd& 3rd prize on appropriate occasion.

Prizes: 1st Gift Items worth - Rs 2000/-.

2nd Gift Items worth - Rs 1500/-

3rd Gift Items worth - Rs 1000/-

2) Participation certificates will be awarded to all the participants who upload their entries for the competition.

We request the State Associations to give wider publicity of this competition and inspire more and more young people to be a part of it and commit themselves to protect the planet **TOGETHER WE CAN BE #GENERATIONRESTORATION".**
