We are pleased to inform you that the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters is organising '**Scouts of World Award Discovery Workshop**' under **Messengers of Peace Project** at the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Training Centre, Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh from **16th to 20th December, 2021**.

The Scouts of the World Award Discovery Workshop Programme will offer the young people i.e. Sr. Scouts & Sr. Guides and Rovers & Rangers an opportunity to acquire the knowledge, skills, and values needed to become an active citizen who can play an innovative role in making the world a better place, starting with the local community. The Scout of the World Award focuses on development, peace, and the environment in supporting community development, ending hunger, combating climate change, decreasing violence, protecting world heritage, and **what global issue do young people care most about, and which one does affect their local community?** The workshop will brainstorm to prepare and identify the global issues that the youth value and act upon them in their local community. Dates	:	16 th to 20 th December, 2021 (05 days)
Date of Reporting	:	16 th December, 2021 09:00 A.M.
Date of Departure	:	20 th December, 2021 03:00 P.M. (Return Reservation may be prepared accordingly)
Venue	:	The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Training Centre, Pachmarhi-461881, Madhya Pradesh.
How to Reach	:	The nearest Railway station is PIPARIYA , which is on Itarsi- Jabalpur Allahabad Railway line. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi is 56 Km by road. Shared Jeep/Taxi are available to Pachmarhi from Pipariya Railway/Bus Station.
Climate	:	During December, Pachmarhi will be cold. Hence, warm Clothing's may be carried accordingly.
Places of Attraction	:	The magnificence of nature has found exquisite expression in myriad enchanting ways in the hill resort- PACHMARHI . A visitor to the National Training Centre enjoys his / her stay by having glimpses of the valley, raving, maze of gorges, sculpted by water and weather, flowering plants, (over 1300 varieties) butterflies (of more than 50 types). The fascinating animal and bird kingdom mesmerize the visitors, Pachmarhi is a ' Trekkers Paradise '. One can walk through the shabby bridle path ribboning through deep and lovely dark green woods. This area is also an archaeological treasure house. It has some of the best caves shelters having prehistoric paintings. There are some religious places, a national park and a museum of rich flora & fauna in Bison Lodge constructed in 1862. Some other attractions of Pachmarhi are historical places like Padava Caves, Rajendra Giri Garden, Latshrung, ReechGarh, HandiKhow, Mahadev Temple, Jata Shankar

		Temple and Chauragarh Temple on the hills. Dhoopgarh sunset point, beautiful waterfalls and the lake for boating are unforgettable visiting places. Going sightseeing in Pachmarhi is most enjoyable. Those seeking adventure will fill their mind with joy and delight under the magnificence of nature. The National Adventure Institute of the Bharat Scout and Guides is also situated at Pachmarhi.
What to Carry by the Participants	:	One set of correct & complete Scout/Guide uniform as per A.P.R.O. Part-II & III, warm bedding/sleeping bag, bed-sheet, writing materials, personal medicines, if any, eating utensils, track-suit & sports shoes to undertake adventure activities, costumes for cultural programme, MOP T-Shirt/BSG T-Shirts, hand sanitizer and mask is mandatory. NB: Participants above 18 years of age must be Covid vaccinated and need to produce Certificate issued by the Government during the registration. Participants Under 18 year should produce RT-PCR Negative Test report taken 72 hours prior to departure for the workshop. This is mandatory. Without vaccination certificate or test report, participants will not be admitted in the workshop.
Eligibility for Participation	:	Senior Scouts/Guides and Rovers/Rangers between the age 15-25 years of age at Least Rajya Puraskar/ Nipun Badge holder is eligible to participate. Preference may be given to Rashtrapati Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger.
Quota Allocation	:	04 Rovers, 02 Rangers, Total=06 from each State Association. One Female unit leader can be deputed to escort the Rangers. Extra participants will not be accepted.
Registration Fee	:	180/- per head is to be deposited during registration being the Scout/Guide Welfare Fund by each participant i.e. Scouts/Guides/Rovers/Rangers and Rs 280/- per head for Adult Leaders.
Financial Support	:	Free Lodging & Boarding during the workshop duration will be provided by the National Headquarters and workshop souvenirs like T-Shirt, Scarf etc.
Last date of Registration	:	The list of participating candidates duly recommended by the State Association should reach National Headquarters at boyprogramme@bsgindia.org with a copy to ntc@bsgindia.org on or before 15th November, 2021. If State Association is not utilizing the allotted quota, please inform the National Headquarters so that additional quota can be allotted to other needy States.

All the State Associations are requested to kindly select and depute the best and deserving candidates for this workshop and make best use of this opportunity to inspire the young people.
