Venue	: The Bharat Scouts and Guides National Youth Complex, Gadpuri, Palwal (Haryana)
Dates	: 09 th to 13 th January, 2022.
Date of Reporting	: 09 th January, 2022 before lunch
Date of Departure	: 13 th January, 2022 after Lunch
How to Reach	: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Gadpuri is situated on the Mathura road in between Palwal and Ballabgarh (just 10 km from Ballabgarh). From SaraiKalen Khan Buses are available for Palwal. Get down at Gadpuri bus stand.➤ Nearest Metro Station is Raja Nahar Singh (Ballabgarh) in Violet line. Direct Metro train services are available from Kashmiri Gate/ Mandi House/ Central Secretariat, Delhi.➤ Raja Nahar Singh (Ballabgarh)to Gadpuri share auto are available.
Registration Fund	: 180/- per head is to be deposited during registration being the Scout/Guide Welfare Fund by each participant i.e. Rovers/Rangers and Rs 280/- per head for Adult Leaders.

Who can Attend	:	Rovers/Rangers who have completed atleast Nipun Badge.
Quota Allocation	:	04 Rovers, 04 Rangers, Total=08 from each State Association. One Female unit Leader can be deputed to escort the Rangers. Extra participants will not be accepted.
Financial Assistance	:	National Headquarters will reimburse travelling subsidy maximum @550/- per head or actual whichever is less on production of train/Bus ticket in original. Free lodging and boarding will be provided during the camp days. Participants of Railway State are requested to utilize Railway Pass.
Programme	:	Recitations, Yogaasanas Presentation, Essay Writing, Youth Forum, Discussion, Slogan Writing, Drawing & Painting, Quiz, Wall Paint Competition, Play acting& skit. Regular activities on "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Clean India project and Cultural Programmes.
What to bring	:	Individual Kit: Usual camp kits, 2 sets of Correct & Complete Uniform as per APRO II/III, Warm Clothing's, Knotting Rope, Personal First Aid Kit, Plate, Glass, Spoon, Torch, Warm Bedding, Traditional Costumes, writing materials, related materials for use during competitions, mask, gloves & Hand Sanitizer. NB: Participants above 18 years of age must be COVID vaccinated and need to produce Certificate issued by the Government during the registration. Participants Under 18 year should produce RT-PCR Negative Test report taken 72 hours prior to departure for the workshop. This is mandatory. Without vaccination certificate or RTPCR test report, participants will not be admitted in the camp.
Last Date	:	The name list of the selected candidates as per the proforma attached should reach at the Bharat Scouts and Guides, NYC, Gadpuri through email at nyc@bsgindia.org before 31th December, 2021 . If your state is not utilizing the allotted quota, please inform us at the earliest (before 25 th December, 2021) so that the additional quota may be allotted to other States.

We personally request the State Association to ensure selecting the right and deserving candidates for this event so as to make this camp a grand success.
