**SUB: (1) DRAFT DOCUMENT ON ALIGNMENT OF BSG YOUTH PROGRAMME UNDER NEW EDUCATION POLICY (NEP)**

**(2) DRAFT DOCUMENT ON CHILD PROTECTION POLICY (CPP)**

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that the Government of India has launched New Education Policy (NEP) in the year 2020, the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters is also now working to align its curriculum with New Education Policy of Government of India.

A Committee was constituted by Hon'ble Chief National Commissioner under the Chairmanship of Smt. Seema Jansuri, Director of Education and State Chief Commissioner, BSG Uttarakhand State to draft a document to align BSG youth programme under New Education Policy. The draft document was placed before the National Programme Committee & National Training Committee in its Virtual meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2021 and National Programme and Training Review Committee Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 respectively. All these 03 committees had a lengthy discussion and recommended that the State Association may organise '**Sandhan**' at the State Level and review the draft document prepared for the purpose and recommend suitable suggestions from the respective sandhan which can be consolidated by the committee at National level constituted for the purpose and place before the competent committees for its final decision.

In this regard, we are enclosing herewith a draft document on alignment of Youth Programme with New Education Policy for your kind perusal and to review which is attached at Annexure '**A**' for your kind perusal.

Secondly, as per the Vision 2024 of BSG, it is recommended that the organisation should have Child Protection Policy (CPP) as the Bharat Scouts and Guides is a Youth Organisation dealing with the young people aged 03-25 years. A draft document on Child Protection Policy is prepared which is also forwarded to you attached at Annexure '**B**' for your kind perusal. This may also be discussed in the Sandhan and appropriate suggestions may be forwarded to National Headquarters for further submission to the

competent Committee to review and to implement Child Protection Policy in the organisation.

State Association is requested to initiate organising the '**State Level Sandhan**' urgently and review both the documents and ensure that the recommendation should reach National headquarters at the earliest possible but not later than **31<sup>th</sup> August, 2021**.

This may please be treated on '**Top priority**'.
