(A) The entire jurisdiction of E.C.Railway:

- (i) Those Indian Citizen who are Employees of E. C. Railway and their Family members i:e spouse, sons, daughter and their dependents (cover under Pass Rule) who subscribes to the Fundamentals, Principles, Methods, Promise and Law.
- (ii) Those indian citizen who are the employees of the CAO/Con/S&N/MHX, CWM/PD/DDU, Workshop/Harnaut & SPJ, RRB/RRC Patna & Muzaffarpur and their spouse, sons, daughter and their dependents (cover under Pass Rule) who subscribes to the Fundamentals, Principles, Methods, Promise and Law.

(B) Those schools which run under the Jurisdiction/Controlled of E.C.Railway:

(i) Those Employees, Teachers and students who are employed/teaching/studying in Railway Pre-School/ Schools/ colleges and aided schools and do not fall under any of the above categories and are ready to subscribe to APRO of Bharat Scouts & Guides and also Bye-Laws of East Central Railway Bharat Scouts & Guides provided they are ready to meet all expenditure as per extant Rules.


(C) Other schools run in Railway colonies and aided/controlled by the E.C. Railway:

Employees, Teachers and Students of those Schools which are run in Railway Colonies which are controlled wholly or Partially by the East Central Railway Administration and who subscribe to the aims and objectives and are members of the Local or District Association affiliated to the State Association.

(2) Retired employees and Family members of retired employees if :-

- (A) They were members of the State Association during the period of service of the said employees, and subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of The East Central Railway Bharat Scouts & Guide, and
- (B) They are ready to bear all expenses including journey expenses and a declaration to this effect has been received and recommended by the District Commissioner concerned.
- (C) Those studying in Railway Schools and Railway aided schools and do not fall under any of the above categories and are ready to subscribe to APRO of Bharat Scouts & Guides and also Bye-Laws of East Central Railway Bharat Scouts & Guides provided they are ready to meet all expenditure as in (2) (B).
- (D) Retired Railway employees may be allowed to conduct Scouts & Guides activities voluntarily. However, No retired Railway employee should be allowed to hold any post at the State/District level. He/She should not be allowed to avail any Railway facilities including honorarium etc or Railway





Passes.

- (3) Non-Railways: In case of non-railway employees and their wards, They are ready to bear all expenses including travel expenses. A declaration to this effect has been received and recommended by the District Commissioner concerned.
- 11. The membership of the State Association shall consists of :-
 - (A) All the District or Divisional Associations of the ECR Bharat Scouts and Guides.
 - (B) Existing Life Members of the State Association.
 - (C) Chairperson of the Local Association affiliated directly with the State in case of no District Association in the district.
 - (D) Group Leader of the group registered directly with the State Association in case of case of no District/Local Association in the district.
 - (E) All office bearers of State Association and District Association.
- 12. Termination of Membership:
 - (i) If any member is found guilty of criminal offence, involving moral turpitude, his/her membership shall be terminated and any Award/Privilege shall be withdrawn.
 - (ii) If any member of any unit/Association/district council or state council/national council while supporting any other Organization is found indulging in activities detrimental to the interests of the movement or bring disrepute to the organization by way of writings in Publications/media or confirmed propaganda against the interests of the movement/ organization shall be liable to be terminated from the organization provided, due enquiry takes place and due opportunity is provided, to the persons (s) to be heard.
 - (iii) If any member of the Bharat Scouts & Guides is found to be a member of any Parallel organization working in the name of Scouting and Guiding or is found aiding and abetting the activities of such an organization, his/her membership of the Bharat Scouts and Guides will be terminated.
 - (iv) If the member or office bearer of any association or council violates any provision(s) of the Code of Conduct as approved and revised periodically by National Executive Committee.
 - (v) If he/she resigns from his/her own in writing and same is accepted by competent authority.
 - (vi) If he/she is transferred from the territorial jurisdiction of East Central Railway State Association.
 - (vii) If he/she ceases her connection with the Railway under the East Central Railway State Association due to his/her dismissal, removal, compulsory retirement or superannuation from service or death.

- (viii) If he/she is Non-Railways attaining the age of 40 years.
- (ix) If any member creating political interference in the movement which creating disturbances.
- (x) If any General Members of the East Central Railway Bharat Scouts and Guides is found to be member of any parallel Organization, his/her membership of the East Central Railway Bharat Scouts and Guides will be terminated.

- 32. Assistant Director of the Region.

The following members will be eligible for consideration as nominated members of State Council:

- 1. Volunteer leaders having not less than twenty years of active association with organization;
- 2. Silver Elephant Awardees residing in the State:
- Donor who has donated one lakh or more to the State Association in the last three financial years provided that they subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of the Movement as well as Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.

Professionals having not less than ten years' experience in the field of Education, Administration, Literature, Finance, Law, Management, and Information Technology provided that they subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of the Movement as well as Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.

4. The State Chief Commissioner shall be the chairman of the State Executive Committee and the Chief Executive Head of the State Association.

Note: The Functions of the State Chief Commissioner shall be: As per BSG Rules Book, Rule No. 67

D State Commissioner of Scouts and State Commissioner of Guides:

- 1. There shall be One State Commissioner of Scouts for Scout wing instead of State Commissioner of Cub, Scout, Rover and State Commissioner of Scouts (Adult Resources) and One State Commissioner of Guides for Guide wing instead of State Commissioner of Bulbul, Guide, Ranger and State Commissioner of Guides (Adult Resources).
- 2. State Commissioner of Scouts and Guides shall be appointed by the State Chief Commissioner from among the CHODs Officers of E.C.Railway.
- 3. State Commissioner of Scouts and Guides shall be appointed for not more than Five years and shall hold office for such a period as may be specified in the Warrant issued by the Chief National Commissioner in accordance with Rules.

Note: The Functions of the State Commissioner of Scout and Guide as the head of their respective wings/section shall be:

- (a) Generally to aid and assist the State Chief Commissioner in the performance of his/her duties in the respective wings.
- (b) To make recommendations for the appointment of Assistant State Commissioner, State Training Commissioner, who is Leader Trainers and Assistant Leader Trainers for their respective wings.
- (c) All matters in respect of the Scout Wing shall be routed to the State Chief Commissioner through the State Commissioner of Scout and all matters in respect of the Guide Wing shall be routed to State Chief Commissioner through State Commissioner of Guide.


- 1. The State Treasurer shall be appointed by State Chief Commissioner on recommendation of State Executive Committee from the Railway Officers of Accounts Department (Junior Administrative Grade and above).
- 2. The State Treasurer shall hold office for a period of not more than five years or for the duration of the State Executive Committee, as the case may be, provided, however, he/she shall continue to hold office until his/her








		The management of the affairs of the East Central Railway Bharat Scouts and Guides vests in the State Executive Committee in accordance with the rules and regulations for the time being in force. (A) Registration of District/Local Association: The District and Local Association shall be registered with the "East Central Railway Bharat Scouts and Guides" State Association.		
		(B) Registration of Group: A Group is registered with the State Association through the District or Local Association for specific period of time as perduration of the State Council.		
	2	Cancellation of Registration :		
		(a) State Chief Commissioner may either suo-moto or on the recommendation of the concerned DC (District Commissioner) suspends the registration of a Group, on such suspension an enquiry by such person and or such line as may be directed, shall be conducted. The Group shall be given an opportunity to be heard and to make representation at such enquiry. On completion of such enquiry the State Chief Commissioner may either withdraw the suspension or for reasons to be recorded cancel the registration of the Group.		
		(b) The concerned DC may suspend the registration of the Group on such suspension an enquiry by such person and on such lines as may be directed shall be conducted, at such enquiry the Group shall be given an opportunity to be heard and make representation, on completion of such enquiry the concerned DC may make recommendation to the SCC (State Chief Commissioner) for cancellation of the registration of the Group and the SCC may on perusal of the papers or on such further enquiry as he may hold or direct either, withdraw the suspension or cancel the registration of the Group.		
		(c) Against order of suspension by the District Commissioners an appeal shall lie with the State Chief Commissioner and the State Chief Commissioner may on such enquiry as he may direct, withdraw the suspension.

- other National or to any embassy or legation in India or abroad except through the State or the National Assn. as the case may be. (C) No member of the association may express opinion in the public or in the press/social media or any matter of policy or principle or be concerned in any broadcast on the Scout-Guide movement without the previous approval of the State or National Assn. as the case may be. Visit and Participants: A) Inter District - No member of the District Association can participate or represent in any other District event without prior sanction of home district. B) Inter State - No member of the State Association shall participate, camp, represent in any other States event without prior sanction of home State Headquarter. C) International - No member shall participate, camp, represent in any of the International event in the foreign country without the prior sanction of home State Headquarter, and National Headquarter. He/she should carry with him/her an International Letter of Introduction issued by NHQ. Camp Warden: Camp Warden and Assistant Camp Warden shall be appointed by the State Chief Commissioner in consultation with the State Secretary as per their terms and conditions laid down by the State Association. Issue of Warrant: (a) Every appointment to the executive rank shall be made by a warrant. (b) The warrant shall be valid for the period for which a person is appointed/nominated as the case may be. On the expiry of the period of warrant the holder shall continue to perform the functions and duties till a successor is appointed or if he/she has to continue should apply for renewal. (d) Notwithstanding the period mentioned, the warrant shall ceased to
 - be enforced when the holders discontinues or fails to perform the functions and duties for which the warrant is issued.
 - No person shall be eligible to hold two or more warrants at the same time and no person shall be eligible to hold a warrant of any other rank at the same time.

If any exceptional case and in the interest of the movement the State Chief Commissioner may permit any person to hold more than one warrant provided, however no person shall hold warrant more than one State Assn.

(f) As soon as the appointment is made for any other rank of commissioners the State Secy, shall place the warrant along with a request, the proforma prescribed before the concerned

commissioner and the State Chief Commissioner for signature and issue.

(g) In the case of sponsored Group the warrant for group leader

(g) In the case of sponsored Group the warrant for group leader (Scout/Guide) applications duly recommended by the concerned sponsoring authority will be sent in the prescribed proforma to the SHQ. In case of warrants for Scouter/Guider of such Group, application recommended by the sponsoring authority and the Group Leader will be sent to the SHQ in the prescribed proforma.

Explain:

- (i) In the case of open Group the warrant for group leader (Scout/Guide) applications duly recommended by the concerned group council will be sent in the prescribed proforma to the SHQ. The copy of Group Council resolution to be attached.
- (ii) In case of warrants for Scouter/Guider of such Group, application recommended by the Group Leader will be sent to the SHQ in the prescribed proforma through District Commissioners concerned. In case of Group Leaders/Commissioners going for higher training where requires attachment certificate of the unit a recommendation may be sent by State Training Commissioner /District Training Commissioner concerned.
- (iii) If a member is transferred from his/her Scouting/Guiding Group to other Division/Workshop other than his/her own due to posting in other place or otherwise, who is residing in his/her home town or not, his/her warrant may be issued from the unit where he/she resides, subject to the recommendation of the District concerned.
- Renewal of Warrants: The warrant shall be renewed by the same authority who has issued the warrant following the same procedure prescribed for issue of warrant as such.
- Withdrawal of Warrants: The warrants of any rank may be withdrawn or surrendered for reasons to be given in writing, the State Chief Commissioner may do so in consultation with the State Commissioners concerned.





N. B. - NO UNIT will be registered without having minimum requisite number of Railway Wards to form a Pack, Troop & Crew and Flock, Company & Team as per APRO II & III.

(a) The Group Registration shall be renewed after 03 years.

(b) However the Individual Registration Fee (IRF) to be paid annually as per extant Rule.





The State Association shall affiliate and register District. Association. Through any District Association, they will also affiliate and register local Association and shall issue charters to such affiliated District or Local Association specifying the area of operation of such Local or District Association . The District and Local Association affiliated and registered with State Association shall pay an annual individual registration fee per member registered with them at the rate fixed by the State Executive Committee from time to time, such payment shall be accompanied by annual census figure and the year shall be the financial year which ends on 31st March every Year. For the purpose of these Bye-Laws every Division of East Central Railway shall be 28 District. Garhara shall also be a District. The State Executive Committee may by a resolution also create a Special District Association at any station where there is concentration of more than 750 Members. 29 The Charter of Local Association shall also be issued by the State Association specifying the area of operation of such Local Association if the Association has a concentration of more than 300 general members and if Association for registration is forwarded by any District Association which they send their representative. The District and Local Association shall have their own Bye laws passed by their 30 councils and approved by the State Chief Commissioner. These Bye-laws shall conform to the rules and the A.P.R.O of the Bharat Scouts and Guides. 31 In the event of any dispute between the members of the Association and/or of the State council and of the Executive Committee regarding the constitution, the Bye-laws and the interpretation there of, appoint of the office bearers conduct of ordinary and special meetings, working of the Executive Committee rights and liabilities of any member of the Executive Committee and /or the State Council, such dispute or difference of opinion shall be referred to the State Chief Commissioner, whose decision in the matter shall be final and binding. Only those LT/ALTs will be member of the State training team who are working railway employees and also Retired LT/ALTs who reside in the jurisdiction of E.C.Railway and will Registered Member. taking any donation prior permission of State Chief Commissioner/State 32 Commissioner (S/G)/State Secy. is must. Note: In case of any dispute, decision of Chief National Commissioner is final in all respect.

These Bye-Laws shall be effective from the date of approval of the Chief National Commissioner. This Bye-Laws is recommended by State Executive Committee in its meeting held on 10.03.2021 & approved by the State Council in its meeting held on 10.03.2021.
