THE BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES, CHANDIGARH STATE ASSOCIATION MODEL BYE-LAWS

- Name: The name of the State Association shall be called 'The Bharat Scouts and Guides
 Chandigarh State Association.
- Short Title: This Bye-Laws shall be called "The Bharat Scouts and Guides Chandigarh State Association Bye-Laws".
- Commencement: This Bye Laws shall come into force on the date of approval by the Chief National Commissioner of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters, New Delhi.
- 4. Definition:
 - (4.1) 'Association' means the Bharat Scouts and Guides, Chandigarh State Association;
 - (3.2) 'Memorandum of Association' means the Memorandum of the Bharat Scouts and Guides;
 - (3.3) 'Rules' means the Rules of the Bharat Scouts and Guides;
 - (3.4) Words and expressions used in these Bye-Laws shall, unless otherwise provided in the Bye-Laws, have the same meaning assigned to them in the Memorandum of Association and the Rules.

5.Address of State Association:

The Bharat Scouts and Guides, Sector 19c Govt. Nursery School Chandigarh State Association.

6. MEMBERSHIP:

The Membership of the Association in the local/district association is open to citizens of India; who subscribe to the Fundamentals, which includes Purpose, Principles, the Methods, the Promise and the Law.

Provided, a citizen of any other nationality residing for the time being in India may be admitted as a member of the local/district association with the approval of the State Chief Commissioner.

Provided, further, that such person subscribes to the Scout or Guide Promise as hereunder:

On my honour I promise that I will do my best to do my duty to God* and India; to help other people and to obey the Scout or Guide Law. Note: "The word "Dharma" may be substituted for the word 'God 'if so desired.

- 6.1. The membership of the State Association shall consist of
 - (A) All the District or Divisional Associations of the Bharat Scouts and Guides.
 - (B) Existing Life Members of the State Association
 - (C) Chairperson of the Local Association affiliated directly with the State in case of no district association in the district
 - (D) Group Leader of the group registered directly with the state association in case of no district/local association in the district
 - (E) Life Members:

Life Members are those who are admitted as such by the State Executive Committee and who have paid Life Membership Fee as prescribed.(All office barrier of State Association).

Note: From the date of approval of these new rules, no life member will be admitted

- Note: I. There will be no further individual membership at State Association and members are either elected, nominated or representative of District Association in the state council.
 - II.Provided, however, the State Council shall have the power to act not withstanding any vacancy in the membership there of.
 - III. Provided, further, that any member of the State Council who is a member by virtue of office shall cease to be a member of the Council when he/she ceases to hold such office.
 - IV. Provided, further that any member who representing the District Association ceased to be the member of the State Council or Executive in case the District Council is dissolved.
- (II) Termination of Membership:
- (i) If any member is found guilty of criminal offence, involving moral turpitude, his/her membership shall be terminated and any award/privilege shall be withdrawn.
- (ii) If any member of any unit/ association/ district council or state council/ national council while supporting any other Organization is found indulging in activities detrimental to the interests of the movement or bring disrepute to the organization by way of writings in publications/media or confirmed propaganda against the interests of the movement/organization shall be liable to be terminated from the organization provided, due enquiry takes place and due opportunity is provided, to the persons(s) to be heard.
- (iii) If any member of the Bharat Scouts and Guides is found to be a member of any Parallel organization working in the name of Scouting and Guiding or is found aiding and abetting the

activities of such an organization, his/her membership of the Bharat Scouts and Guides will be terminated.

- (iv) If the member or office bearer of any association or council violates any provision(s) of the Code of Conduct as approved and revised periodically by National Executive Committee.
- 7. Board of Patron: There shall be a board of Patrons as follows:
- Chief-Patron: The Governor or Lt. Governor / Administrator of UT Chandigarh shall be invited to be the Chief Patron of the State Association.
- 2. Vice-Patron: The Advisor to the Governor or Lt. Governor / Administrator of UT Chandigarh shall be invited to be the Vice- Patron of the State Association who pay such contribution or donation as may be determined by the State Executive Committee, and are admitted assuch by the State Executive Committee.
- 3. The President of the State Association shall be the Education Secretary of the Chandigarh Administration, Govt. of UT Chandigarh.
- The Vice President shall be nominated by the President of the Association in consultation with State Council.
- The State Chief Commissioner Director School Education Chandigarh Administration, Govt.
 Of UT Chandigarh shall be nominated as State Chief Commissioner by the virtue of office.
- 8. State Council:

The State Council shall consists of:

- 19. All District Organizing Commissioners of Guides;
- 20. All Leader Trainers of Scouts holding valid Honourable Charges;
- 21. All Leader Trainers of Guides holding valid Honourable Charges;
- 22. Special Invitees: The State Chief Commissioner may invite special invitees in consultation with the State Commissioner (Headquarters) of the State Association.
- 23. Assistant Director of the Region.

The following members will be eligible for consideration as nominated member of State Council:

- Volunteer leaders having not less than twenty years of active association with organization;
- 2. Silver Elephant Awardees residing in the State;
- Donor who has donated one lakh or more to the State Association in the last three financial years provided they subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of the Movement as well as Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.
- 4. Professionals having not less than ten years' experience in the field of Education, Administration, Literature, Finance, Law, Management, and Information Technology provided they subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of the movement as well asCode of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.

Note: Provided further, the National Office Bearers of the National Association residing in the state shall be invited as a Special Invitees in the State Council Meeting.

B. Special Meeting:

As per BSG Rule 62.4

9. Electoral College:

- a. There shall be No Electoral College for the election for the office of Patron, Vice Patron, President and the State Chief Commissioner in UT Chandigarh. All the appointments in the State and District association are done by the process of Nomination or Unanimously Elected by State Chief Commissioner or by State Headquarter Commissioner (may be with the consultation of State Commissioner Scouts/Guides).
- 10. Finance Committee: As per BSG Rule 77.
- Election of Patron, Vice Patron, President and the State Chief Commissioner:

There shall be No election of the Patron, Vice Patron, President and the State Chief Commissioner in UT Chandigarh. The state Council may invite the Patron, Vice Patron, President and the State Chief Commissioner.

- 12. Election to the State Executive Committee: As Per BSG Rule 78.
- 13. No professional of the State or District shall be eligible to participate in the Election process as there is no election in UT Chandigarh.
- 14. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief National Commissioner shall be final.
- 15. These Bye Laws shall be effective from the date of approval of the Chief National Commissioner.

16. This Byelaws is recommended by the State Executive committee in its meeting on 11 September 2021 and approved by the State Council in its meeting held on 18 september 2021.
