#### BYE- LAWS OF WESTERN RAILWAY STATE BHARAT SCOUTS & GUIDES

- Short Title: These bye laws shall be called "The Western Railway State Bharat Scouts & Guides, State Association Bye-Laws.
- Name: Name of the state Association shall be "THE WESTERN RAILWAY STATE BHARAT SCOUTS & GUIDES.
- Registered Office:- The registered office of the State Association shall be the State Headquarter Office, 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Station Building, Churchgate, Mumbai- 400020.
- 4. <u>Affiliation</u>: The State Association shall be affiliated to the National Association and on such affiliation, the National Association shall issue a Charter signed by the Chief National Commissioner and The Director and by virtue of such Charter only the State Association shall function as such.
- Aims and Objects: The State Association shall confirm and adhere to the Aims, Policies, Rules & Organization and try to achieve the Targets of the National Association. State Association shall confirm and adhere to the policies of Railway Board (Apex Body called the Railways Scouts & Guides Board) issued from time to time.

Objectives of WR State Association:

- i) Try, to achieve the targets of Railway Scouts & Guides Board.
- ii) Progress of scouting movement on the Indian Railways.
- State Association members should be encouraged to several social service works andvarious awareness programmes organized by Indian Railways.
- To building character and inculcating a sense of discipline to members of association.
- v) To encourage the members in Public service.
- vi) To give impetus to the Scouts & Guides movement on the Indian Railways.
- 6. Annual Fees: The State Association shall pay to the National Association annually such Affiliation fee and such annual Individual Registration Fee as may be fixed by the National Executive Committee and approved by the National Council from time to time and in default of such payment within a period of twelve months after the closure of the financial year for which the fees are due or within such extended period of time by

the Chief National Commissioner being more than six months, the office bearers and elected representatives of the State Association on the National Council and the National Executive Committee shall not be entitled to attend, participate or vote at or stand for any election to the National Council and the National Executive Committee till such dues are paid.

7. <u>Legal</u>: If any legal matter filed/arise against official of Western Railway State Association , the same cum, dealt by the officer of Western Railway Sate Association to whom President or Sate Chief Commissioner of Western Railway State Association can nominate.

#### 8. Definitions:

- a) Association means the Western Railway State Bharat Scouts & Guides
- b) Rules Means the Rules of Bharat Scouts & Guides.
- Words and expression used in these Bye- Laws shall, unless otherwise provided in the Bye-laws, have the same meaning assigned to them in the Memorandum of Association and the rules.

9. Membership:

- 1. The Western Railway State Association is open to those Indian citizen's who are permanent employee of Western Railway and their family members /dependent family members as per Railway Pass Rule and Medical Treatment Rules (Indian railway Medical Manual) Railway employees residing who subscribe to aim and objects of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, on the recommendation of the State Chief Commissioner
- 2. The students and regular teachers of Railway Schools may be allowed as member as provided for in the rules on the recommendation of the State Chief Commissioner.
- 3. Non Rlys:- Sons and Daughter of Rly Employee's who joined in any Registered Scouts or Guides Group of any District Association under W.Rly during currency of service of their father/Mother/Guardian may continue even after their retirement, may continue the maximum age should be 33years, Direct entry as a Rover/Ranger/Unit Leader will not be allowed

Provided, further, that such person subscribes to the Scout or Guide Promise as hereunder:

"On my honour I promise that I will do my best to do my duty to God\* and India to help other people and to obey the Scout or Guide Law.

Note: \*The word "Dharma" may be substituted for the word 'God' if so desired.

# 10. The membership of the State Association shall consist of:

- (a) All the District or Divisional Associations of the WR State Bharat Scouts and Guides.
- (b) Existing Life Members of the WR State Association.
- (c) Chairperson of the Local Association affiliated directly with the State in case of no district association in the district.
- (d) Group Leader of the group registered directly with the state association in case of no district/local association in the district.
- (e) All the office bearers of the State Association.4
  (as per Rule 54 of New Rule Book of The Bharat Scouts & Guides)

There will be no further individual membership at State Association and members are either elected, nominated or representative of District Association in the state council.

Provided, however, the State Council shall have the power to act not withstanding any vacancy in the membership thereof.

Provided, further, that any member of the State Council who is a member by virtue of office shall cease to be a member of the Council when he/she ceases to hold such office.

Provided, further that any member representing the District Association ceased to be the member of the State Council or Executive in case the District Council is dissolved.

# 11. Termination of Membership:

- (1) If any member is found guilty of criminal offence, involving moral turpitude, his/her membership shall be terminated and any award/privilege shall be withdrawn.
- (2) If any member of any unit/ association/ district council or state council/ national council while supporting any other Organization is found indulging in activities detrimental to the interests of the movement or bring disrepute to the organization by way of writings in publications/ media or confirmed propaganda against the interests of the movement/ organization shall be liable to be terminated from the organization provided, due enquiry takes place and due opportunity is provided, to the persons(s) to be heard.
- (3) If any member of the Bharat Scouts & Guides is found to be a member of any Parallel organization working in the name of Scouting and Guiding or is found aiding and abetting the activities of such an organization, his/her membership of the Bharat Scouts and Guides will be terminated.
- (4) If the member or office bearer of any association or council violates any provision(s) of the Code of Conduct as approved and revised periodically by National Executive Committee.

  - 16) The State Training Commissioner of Scouts;17) The State Training Commissioner of Guides;
  - 18) All the District Chief Commissioners or Divisional Chief Commissioner,
  - 19) All District Commissioners or Divisional Commissioners;
  - 20) All the Assistant District Commissioners in charge of Local Association where there isno District Association;
  - 21) All Leader Trainers of Scouts holding valid Honorable Charges;
  - 22) All Leader Trainers of Guides holding valid Honorable Charges;
  - 23) All the District Secretaries or Divisional Secretaries;
  - 24) All the JT. District Secretaries or Jt. Divisional Secretaries
  - 25) All the Local Association Secretaries if there is no district association.
  - 26) Two young leaders below the age of 29 years co-opted by the President from among the members of the State Youth Committee on recommendation of State Chief Commissioner, one of whom shall be a woman.

  - (ii) Silver Elephant Awardees residing in the State; Provided further, the National Office Bearers of the National Association residing in the state shall be invited as a Special Invitees in the State Council Meeting.

# 15. Meetings of the State Council:

(1) Ordinary Meeting::

- (a) The State Council shall ordinarily meet once in every year but not later than 31st August in consultation with the President and with senior Vice President in the absence of the President. Provided, if for any valid reason it is not possible to hold the meeting within the aforesaid date, the matter shall be reported to the Chief National Commissioner along with the reasons for not holding the meeting within the stipulated time
- (b) Notice of such meeting with time, date and place shall be sent to the members not less than 15 days before the date of the meeting and the agenda be sent to the members not less than 07 days before the date of the meeting by email or courier.

Provided further , due to any emergency situation like Covid-19 pandemic, virtual meeting of the State Council can be organised with a 7 days of notice.

- (c) Notice of resolutions duly proposed and seconded and subjects for the consideration of the State Council shall reach the State Secretary not less than thirty days before the date of the meeting; such resolutions and subjects shall be communicated to the members of the State Council 10 days before the date of the meeting.
- (d) Quorum for the meeting shall be one-tenth of the total number of members of the State Council or 20 members whichever is less.
- (e) All questions before the State Council shall be decided by a simple majority of votes. In the case of equal votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote in addition to his own vote.
- (f) The President shall preside over the meeting of the State Council; in the absence of the President , one of the Vice-Presidents, senior by age, present shall preside. In the absence of the President and the Vice-Presidents, one of the members elected by members present shall preside.

  - To make recommendations for the appointment of Assistant State Commissioners, State Training Commissioners, Leader Trainers and Assistant Leader Trainers for their respective Wings;
  - c) All matters in respect of particular section shall be routed to the State Chief Commissioner through the concerned State Commissioner. They will be head of the particular section and its programme planning, implementation and evaluation.
  - d) One of the senior State Commissioner of any of the section by experience will be the Chairperson of the Programme Committee and of other wing senior by experience will be the Co-chairperson. The rest shall be the members.
  - e) The State Commissioner for Scouts (Adult Resources) and The State Commissioner for Guides (Adult Resources) will be head of the Training, its development, Planning, implementation and evaluation. The State Commissioner of Adult Resources senior by experience will be the Chairperson of the Adult Training Committee and Adult Resource Management Committee and other will be the Co-chairperson.

# 31. The Meeting of State Executive Committee:

- (1) (a) The State Executive Committee shall meet at **least twice in a** year and as often as may be decided by the State Chief Commissioner; (b) The State Chief Commissioner shall preside over the meetings of the
- (b) The State Chief Commissioner shall preside over the meetings of the State Executive Committee and in the absence of the State Chief Commissioner, the State Commissioner senior by service shall preside and in the absence State Chief Commissioner and the State Commissioners, any member of the State Executive Committee present and elected may preside;
- (2) (a) six Members representing the District Association shall form the quorum;
  - (b) If within half an hour after the time appointed for the meeting, the quorum is not present, the meeting shall stand adjourned for one hour from the appointed time to be held at the same place and at such adjourned meeting not withstanding want of quorum, the members present may transact the business tabled for the meeting, but no other business.
- (3) Notice of the meeting with time, date and place and the agenda shall be sent by post/ email/ edak to the members not less than Ten days before the date of the meeting. Provided further ,due to any emergency situation like COVID-19 Pandemic, virtual meeting of the State Executive Committee can be organised with a 3 days notice.

  At the instance of the State Chief Commissioner, urgent matters may be passed in circulation by the State Executive Committee by a majority of the total membership and the same shall be reported to the State Executive Committee at its next meeting.

## 32. State Adult Resources Management Committee:

- (i) There shall be a State Adult Resource Management Committee consisting of State Commissioners (Headquarters), Asst. State Commissioners, State Trg.. Commissioners, State Org. Commissioners. The State Chief Commissioner may nominate six District Commissioners, six District Training Commissioners; out of whom three shall be woman from each category, two members from Youth Committee one of whom shall be women and other members as may be deemed fit by State Chief Commissioner to give recommendations periodically to the State Council and State Executive Committee about the all-round development and management of adult resources in the movement.

#### 35. State Youth Committee:


The State Youth Committee shall consist of All the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the District Youth Committee.

1) The State Youth Committee Chairperson and Co-Chairperson shall be nominated by the State Chief Commissioner. One of the Chairperson and Co-Chairperson shall be a woman. One of the members as may be nominated by the Chairperson shall function as Secretary.

2) The Committee shall function in co-terminus with the State Council or till the new committee is formed.

Provided further, if there is no nomination from Division/District, The State Chief Commissioner may nominate the members from the concern Division/Dist.

3) The Youth Committee shall make recommendations to the State
