


BYE LAWS OF THE STATE ASSOCIATION

2022

The amended Bye Laws of the Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides was unanimously approved by the State Council held on 25th September, 2022 at the State Headquarters of the Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides, Patna on the recommendation of the State Executive Committee held on 13th September 2022.

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FOREWORD

As a member of the World Scouting/Guiding movement, the Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides has always adhered to good governance and adopted the best practices. It is firmly believed that all decisions ought to stand upon principles and every leader must find out what the principle is upon which the issue before them should be decided.


Recently, the National Association of the Bharat Scouts & Guides has made amendments to the rules. The Bye Laws of Bihar State BS&G was enacted more than two decades back. It was felt a necessity of the time to amend and update the Bye Laws by which Scouting/Guiding in Bihar should be governed. Accordingly, the State Executive Committee has assigned this vital task to the legal advisor of the State Association, Shri Ashutosh Kumar. I, on behalf of Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides, pay heartfelt gratitude to him for drafting new Bye Laws which will be one of the most important documents for the Scouting/Guiding movement in the State of Bihar.

Bye Laws may be considered as blood of the organization. As an experienced leader, you will perceive many things more easily by experience than through Bye Laws. However, Bye Laws prescribe the way by which the duties and rights of every member of the Scouting/Guiding fraternity in Bihar are to be regulated.

I hope that the adherence of these Bye Laws will help Scouting/Guiding to flourish and achieve new heights in Bihar.

BYE LAWS, 2022

1. SHORT TITLE:

The amended Bye laws shall be known as "The Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides Bye Laws, 2022".

2. EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT:

It extends to the whole of the State of Bihar.

It shall come into force from the date of notification by the State Chief Commissioner.

3. DEFINITIONS:

In this Bye Laws, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, -

- (1). "Association" means The Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guide
- (2). "Bye Laws" means The Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides Bye Laws, 2022
- (3). "State Chief Commissioner" means the State Chief Commissioner of the Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides
- (4). "Memorandum of Association" means the Memorandum of the Bharat Scouts & Guides
- (5). "Rules" means the existing rules of the Bharat Scout & Guides, National Association as amended and notified by the National Association from time-to-time
- (6). "Bihar State BS&G" means The Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides

Note 1: These Bye Laws should be read in conjunction with the Rules of the Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Association

Note 2: Words and expressions used but not defined in these Bye-laws and defined in the Rules book of the Bharat Scouts & Guides have the meaning assigned to them in the Rules Book as amended and notified by the National Association time-to-time.

4. STATE ASSOCIATION:

There shall be a State Association for the territorial jurisdiction of the Bihar State of the Indian Union as determined by the National Executive Committee of the Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Association. It shall consist of a State Association, Divisional Organization, District Associations, Local Association and Group Organization, as the case may be, in accordance with the Rules of the Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Association and Bye Laws of the Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides.

5. NAME:

The name of the State Association shall be "The Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides".


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6. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The Registered Office of the State Association shall be at The Bihar State Bharat Scouts & Guides, Budh Marg, Patna, Bihar- 800001.

7. BRANCH OFFICE:

The State Council may notify any place or places as branch office/offices of the State Association due to administrative reasons for specific periods which may be extended or curtailed by the State Council.

8. PURPOSE:

The purpose of the State Association is to carry out the Aims, Objects, Policies and Programme of the Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Association within the territory of the Bihar State, in accordance with the Memorandum of Association, Rules, A.P.R.O. and the Bye-laws.

9. GOVERNING BODY:

The management of the affairs of the State Association shall be entrusted to the State Executive Committee which will be constituted and exercise its power & functions in accordance with the clauses 78, 79, 80, 81, 82 of the Rules and the Bye-Laws in force.

10. MEMBERSHIP:

Membership of the State Association shall be in accordance with clauses 53, 54 and 55 of the Rules.

Provided that the expression "existing life members of the State Association" as mentioned in clause 54.2 of the Rules should be interpreted as below:

The existing life membership of members who have completed ten years or more will cease from the date of notification of this Bye Laws. Further, the life membership of members who have not yet completed ten years will automatically cease on completion of ten years as a life member.

11. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

The termination of membership shall be governed as per clause 56 of the Rules.

Provided, that the membership shall also stands terminated, if member fails to serve the movement properly in the rank or position held by such member in the opinion of the State Council, State Executive Committee or State Chief Commissioner, as the case may be. The warrant may be



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ceased/withdrawn/suspended by the issuing authority if he/she holds a warrant and it may also cease if he/ she remains in arrears of any dues to the State Association. Further, he/she ceases to be a member of the body/ unit which he/ she represents or belongs to.

Provided, further, that the State Chief Commissioner shall be the final authority to determine membership of a person of the State Association excluding members of the Board of Patrons, Vice-Patron(s), President or Vice President(s) of the State Association.

Provided, further, that an appeal may lie before the State Executive Committee against the decision of the State Chief Commissioner within thirty days of receipt of the decision. The decision shall be communicated through speed post of Indian Post and it shall be deemed to have been served on the day of posting. The decision of the State Executive Committee shall be final and no second appeal shall lie.


Provided, further, that if the appeal is not filed within a stipulated time, the appeal shall not be admitted by the State Executive Committee, unless the State Executive Committee is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from filing the appeal in the prescribed time.

Provided, further, that the State Executive Committee shall be the final authority in the case of members of the Board of Patrons and Vice-Patrons(s). No appeal shall lie against the decision of the State Executive Committee.

Provided, further, that the State Council shall be the final authority in the case of the State President, Vice Presidents(s) and the State Chief Commissioner. No appeal shall lie against the decision of the State Council.

Provided, further, that the State Council by its majority of 2/3rd members present and voting supported by more than 50% of the total effective strength of the State Council may remove the President, Vice-Presidents(s) or the State Chief Commissioner. The effective strength of the State Council implies that out of the total strength of the council, the vacant seats shall not be considered as strength of the State Council. The notice of such a meeting with time, date and place shall be sent to all the members not less than thirty days before the date of the meeting and the agenda be sent to the members not less than twenty days before the date of the meeting by speed post of Indian Post. The State Secretary shall keep a proper record of proof of intimation to members of the State Council.


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Provided, further, that the State Council, State Executive Committee or State Chief Commissioner, as the case may be, shall not be under obligation to state the reason for the decision taken by them.

12. BOARD OF PATRON:

There shall be a Board of Patrons of the State Association in accordance to clause 57 of the Rules.

The Governor or the Chief Minister of the State of Bihar shall be invited to be the Chief Patron of the State Association.

Further, the Minister in charge of the department of Youth Affairs and Sports, Education, Women and Child Welfare, Skill Development, Home Minister or any other Minister of the Government of Bihar may be invited as a member of the Board of Patrons by the State Executive Committee. Provided, further, that any member of the Board of Patrons who is a member by virtue of office shall cease to be a member of the Board of Patrons when he/she ceases to hold such office.

Provided further, the State Executive Committee may invite any eminent person(s) as a member of the Board of Patrons who subscribes to the Fundamentals, which includes the purpose, principles, methods, the Promise and the Law of the organization as well as the Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.


Provided, further, that person shall serve as a member of the Board of Patrons till his/her successor is appointed or the State Executive Committee, in its discretion, decides to cease the appointment. Further, the appointment shall automatically cease if the membership of that person is terminated as per clause 56 of the Rules read with clause 11 of the Bye Laws.

13. VICE PATRON:

There may be one or more Vice Patrons of the State Association as decided by the State Executive Committee.

Provided that Vice Patron(s) of the State Association is open to an eminent person who subscribes to the Fundamentals, which includes the purpose, principles, methods, promise and the Law of the organization as well as the Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization and contribute or donate an amount of Rupees eleven thousand or any such amount as determined by the State Executive Committee from time-to-time.

Provided, further, that the person must be admitted as such by the State Executive Committee, in its discretion.

Provided, further, that person shall serve as Vice-Patron till his/her successor is appointed or the State Executive Committee, in its discretion, decides to cease the appointment. Further, the appointment shall automatically cease if the membership of that person is terminated as per clause 56 of the Rules read with clause 11 of the Bye Laws.

Note 1:

Eminent person means a person who has hold/held a leadership position in public life for not less than twenty-five years or professionals having not less than twenty years' experience in the field of Education, Administration, Literature, Finance, Law, Management and Information Technology.

Note 2:

The membership stand terminates, if he/ she sends his/her resignation to the State Secretary and the same is accepted by the State Executive Committee.

14. STATE COUNCIL:

The State Council shall be constituted and its duration, power & function will be in accordance with clauses 58, 59, 60, 61 and 62 of the Rules.

Provided, further, that Advisors appointed by the State Executive Committee shall also be members of the State Council.

Provided, further, that notices of meeting shall be sent by speed post of Indian Post to the registered address of the members and it shall be deemed to have been duly served on the day of posting.

Provided, further, that every member shall communicate his/ her address to the State Secretary who shall enter it into a register maintained for the purpose. Any member who fails to communicate and register his/her address may not be entitled to have notice of meeting served upon him/ her and will be required to make his/ her own arrangement to find out the place, date and time of the meeting.

Provided, further, that accidental omission to give notice of a meeting to a member entitled to receive notice, thereof non-receipt of notice by any member shall not invalidate the proceedings of the meeting.

Provided, further, that at the instance of the State Chief Commissioner, urgent matters may be passed in circulation by the State Executive Committee by a



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majority of the total members and the same shall be reported to the State Council at its next meeting.

Provided, further, that the State Secretary shall mandatorily convey the meeting of State Council within forty days from the date of receipt of resolution and subjects for consideration as per clause 62 of the Rules.

15. ELECTION OF PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT AND STATE CHIEF COMMISSIONER:


The President, Vice-President and the State Chief Commissioner shall be elected by the State Council at an ordinary meeting or a special meeting called for the purpose of the State Council in accordance with the rules and the Bye-Laws.

The election of the President, Vice-President and State Chief Commissioner shall be in accordance with clauses 59, 64, 65 and 66 of the Rules.

16. CONDUCT OF ELECTION:


- i. The State Secretary shall send notice of the meeting together with the members of the electoral College not less than forty days before the date of the meetings. The notice shall specify the time, date and the place of the meetings and the agenda for the meeting with special reference to the election. The notice shall also specify the last date for receipt of nomination, the date of scrutiny of nomination, the last date of withdrawal of candidature and the date on which a poll, if necessary, will be held.
- ii. Only a person eligible under the rules shall be for the offices of the President or the Vice President or the State Chief Commissioner.
- iii. The nomination shall be made in the prescribed form as approved by the State Council
- iv. The proposer and the seconder shall be members of Electoral College.
- v. The nomination shall be signed by the proposer and the seconder and the candidate.
- vi. A member may subscribe either as proposer or seconder only in as many nominations as there are vacancies.


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- vii. The nomination must reach the State Secretary who shall be the Returning Officer not less than twenty days before the date of the meeting.
- viii. A nomination which is not in the prescribed form or which does not reach the State Secretary before the time and date prescribed or which is not signed by the proposer or seconder of the candidate or which contains the name of a person as a candidate who is not eligible to be nominated to the officer or if a person as proposer or seconder who is not eligible to propose or second shall be invalid.
- ix. The State Secretary who serves as the Returning Officer shall scrutinise the nomination on the date appointed for scrutiny and declare the nomination as valid or invalid.
- x. The State Secretary shall prepare a list of valid nominations, publish it on the notice-board of State Headquarters and **send a copy to the contesting candidate for intimation by email on the intimated email address.** It shall also be placed on the website of the State Association, if available.
- xi. Any candidate may withdraw his candidature by written intimation signed by him and delivered to the State Secretary in person or by **registered post of Indian Post or email**, within the time and date fixed for withdrawal.
- xii. On the expiry of the time and date fixed for withdrawal, the State Secretary shall prepare a list of contesting candidates and publish it on the notice board of the State Headquarters and website of the State Association.
- xiii. If the number of candidates duly nominated is equal to the number of vacancies, the State Secretary shall declare the candidates duly elected. If the number of candidates' duly nominated is less than the number of vacancies the State Secretary shall declare the candidates duly elected and arrange for fresh election for the remainder of the vacancies, and shall fix the time and dates for receipt or nomination, scrutiny, withdrawal and poll, if necessary.
- xiv. If the number of candidates is more than the number of vacancies, an election shall take place at a meeting of the State Council and the election shall be by secret ballot.
- xv. Every member shall have only one casting vote. Where the number of vacancies is more than one, each member shall have as many votes as there are vacancies; provided, however, no member shall cast more than one vote for each candidate. No vote shall be given by proxy.


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- xvi. The ballot paper shall be in the prescribed form as approved by the State Council and shall contain the names of the candidates in alphabetical order.
- xvii. The ballot paper shall bear the official mark of the State Secretary who serves as the Returning Officer.
- xviii. The returning officer shall fix the time for the poll and issue the ballot paper to the members and shall enter the names of the members to whom ballot papers have been issued in a separate register kept for the purpose. The member who receives the ballot paper should go to the desk provided for the purpose, put the mark X with a seal provided for the purpose of the name of the candidate. When he/she decides to cast his/her vote, he/she should fold the ballot paper and put it in the ballot box.
- xix. On expiry of the time fixed for the poll, the returning Officer shall arrange to collect the ballot paper and count the votes, for which purpose, he/she shall appoint as many persons not being candidates as are necessary to assist him.
- xx. A ballot paper shall be invalid:-
- If it is not in the prescribed form and does not bear the official mark of the returning officer; or
 - If it bears the signature of the voter or mark by which the voter becomes recognizable; or
 - If it does not contain the seal (x) mark against a candidate or contains the Seal (x) mark against more than one candidate, in case when only one person is to be elected or if it contains more Seal (x) marks, then the number of candidates to be elected to the office; or
 - If it is not clear as to the person in whose favour the vote is cast.
- xxi. The person who secures the largest number of votes shall be declared elected to the office; in case the election is for more than one vacancy the person securing the largest number of votes in the order of the number of vacancies shall be declared to the office.
- xxii. In the event of equality of votes, the decision shall be by draw of lot.

17. ASSUMPTION OF CHARGE:

The newly elected office-bearers shall be deemed to have assumed charge immediately after the end of a meeting of the State Council for electing new office bearer(s) and the result of the election is declared by the returning


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officer. Till such elections are held and new personnel is elected, the old personnel will continue to hold office.

18. THE OFFICE BEARERS AND OFFICERS OF THE STATE ASSOCIATION

The Office bearers and Officers of the State Association are as per clause 63 of the Rules.

Provided, further, that the Advisor(s) of the State Association shall also be the office bearer of the State Association.

Provided, further, that provisions pertaining to the Office Bearers and officers mentioned in clauses 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75 and 76 of the Rules will be, as the case may be, applicable.

19. STATE FINANCE COMMITTEE

The composition, term, powers and functions of the State Finance Committee shall be as per clause 77 of the Rules.

20. STATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The composition, term, powers, functions and meeting of the State Executive Committee shall be as per clause 78, 79, 80, 81 and 82 of the Rules.


Provided, further, that the State Executive Committee shall have power to appoint the Advisor(s) of the State Association and fix an honorarium for rendering advice.

Provided, further, that the Advisor(s) of the State Association shall also be a member of the State Executive Committee.

Provided, further, that the power to determine the membership of a person as mentioned in clause 81.18 of the Rules should be read in conjunction with clause 11 of these Bye Laws. The State Executive Committee shall serve as appellate authority against the decision of the State Chief Commissioner in determining the membership of a person.

Provided, further, that a meeting of the newly elected State Executive Committee shall be held as possible but not later than fifteen days from the declaration of the result of the election for new office bearers.

Provided, further, that notices of meeting shall be sent by **registered post** of Indian Post and email to the registered address/email of the members and, they shall be deemed to have been duly served on the day of posting/sending.

Provided, further, that every member shall communicate his/ her address and email to the State Secretary who shall enter it into a register maintained for the purpose. Any member who fails to communicate and register his/her address and email may not be entitled to have notice of meeting served upon him/ her and will be required to make his/ her own arrangement to find out the place, date and time of the meeting.

Provided, further, that accidental omission to give notice of a meeting to a member entitled to receive notice, thereof non-receipt of notice by any member shall not invalidate the proceedings of the meeting.

Provided, further, that at the instance of the State Chief Commissioner, urgent matters may be passed in circulation by the State Executive Committee by a majority of the total members and the same shall be reported to the State Executive Committee at its next meeting.

21. STATE ADULT RESOURCES MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:

The composition, term, powers and functions of the State Adult Resources Management Committee shall be as per clause 83 of the Rules.

22. STATE PROGRAMME COMMITTEE:

The composition, term, powers and functions of the State Programme Committee shall be as per clause 84 of the Rules.

23. STATE TRAINING COMMITTEE

The composition, term, powers and functions of the State Training Committee shall be as per clause 85 of the Rules.

24. STATE YOUTH COMMITTEE:

The composition, term, powers and functions of the State Youth Committee shall be as per clause 86 of the Rules.


25. DISAGREEMENT:

- i. In case of disagreement among the members of Group level, the matter should be referred to the Group Council for its decision. If dissatisfied with the decision by the Group Council, the matter shall be brought to the notice of the District Commissioner concerned and his/ her decision shall be final and binding on all conditions. The District Commissioner will inform the District Executive Committee about the dispute and his findings.
- ii. In case of any disagreement between the members of the District Association, the matter shall first be placed before the District Executive Committee, for its decision. If dissatisfied with the decision of the District Executive committee, the matter may be referred to the State Chief Commissioner. The State Chief Commissioner may himself decide the matter or may place the matter before the State Executive Committee. The decision so arrived at shall be final and binding.
- iii. In case of any disagreement amongst the members of the State Association, the matter shall be referred to the State Chief commissioner who will decide the dispute after hearing all the parties, or the matter may be referred to the State Executive Committee and its decision shall be final and binding on all concerned.

26. SUITS:

The State Association can sue and be sued in the name of the State Secretary in a Court of Law under whose jurisdiction the State Headquarters of the State Association lies.


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The State Headquarters of the State Association, the Bihar State Bharat Scout and Guides, is at Budh Marg, Patna under P.S. Kotwali, Patna in the District of Patna, Bihar.

27. DIVISIONAL ORGANISATION

The composition, term, powers and functions of the Divisional Organization, if approved by the State Executive Committee, shall be as per Chapter IV of the Rules.

28. DISTRICT ASSOCIATION:

The composition, term, powers and functions of the District Association shall be as per Chapter V of the Rules.

Provided, that the account of the District Association will be operated jointly by the District Chief Commissioner, District Secretary and District Treasurer and in operating the Bank Account of the District Association, the signature of the District Chief Commissioner is essential and the other signature either of the District Secretary or District Treasurer in mandatory.

Provided further that the District shall pay an Annual Registration fee collected from Cubs/Bulbul, Scouts/Guides, Rovers/ Rangers, Scouters/Guiders and Commissioners of all ranks as decided by the State Executive Committee. The payment shall be accompanied by the census figures, the Annual Report and Audited statement of accounts, in default of this and of ; such payment within a period of twelve months after the closure of the Financial Year for which the fees are due, the office bearers and elected representatives of the District Association on State Council and on the State Executive Committee shall not be entitled to attend, participate, vote, stand for any election held for the State Council and the State Executive Committee till such dues are paid.

29. APPORTION OF REGISTRATION FEE:

The Annual Individual Registration fee collected from Cub/Bulbul, Scouts/Guides, Rovers/Rangers, Scouters/Guiders and Commissioners of all ranks shall be apportioned as decided by the State Executive Committee time to time.

30. LOCAL ASSOCIATION

The composition, term, powers and functions of the Local Association, if

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approved by the State Executive Committee, shall be as per Chapter-VI of the Rules.

31. GROUP ORGANISATION

The composition, term, powers and functions of the Group Organization shall be as per Chapter-VII of the Rules.

Provided that the Group shall pay the registration and renewal fee as decided by the State Executive Committee.

Provided, further that only after registration at the State Headquarters, a Group is recognized as a Unit of the Bharat Scouts and Guides and is entitled to wear the Badges, use its Flag or in any way represent themselves as members of the Bharat Scouts and Guides.

Provided, further, that the Group will apply for registration to the State Association through the Local or District Association, as the case may be, on forms in triplicate, supplied by the State Headquarters, along with the Group registration fee.

Provided, further, that the Registration shall be renewed annually and Registration of a Group shall be valid till 31st March every year. The Group shall send the Registration fee and the Annual Census every year before 31st March.

Provided, further, that the Group Registration Fee shall be apportioned equally between the District and State Association.

32. INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION FEE:

- (i) All members including Cubs, Scouts, Rovers, Bulbuls, guides, Rangers, Scouters, Guiders, Commissioners and others shall pay annually an Individual Registration Fee as fixed by the National Headquarters/State Headquarters from time to time.
- (ii) Group shall collect the Individual Registration Fee from their Cubs, Scouts, Rovers and Scouters or Bulbuls, guides, Rangers and Guiders as the case may be and send the entire amount so collected to the District or Local Association, as the case may be.



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- (iii) District or Local Association, as the case may be shall collect the Individual Registration fee from their Commissioners, other office-bearers, District Scouters/Guiders and send the entire amount so collected and also the amount received from the Groups to the State Headquarters.

33. INTERPRETATION OF THE BYE-LAWS:

In case of any dispute or differences with regard to the interpretation of any clause of Bye-Laws, the matter shall be referred to the State Executive Committee whose decision shall be final and binding. In case of conflict of Interest, the issue may be referred to the State Council, whose decision shall be final and binding.

34. REPEAL AND SAVING

- i. The Bharat Scouts & Guides Bihar State Association Bye-laws approved by the State Council and duly accorded by the National Commissioner on 09.04.2003 is hereby repealed.

ii. Notwithstanding such repeal, any order, rule, notification, guidelines or appointment made or anything done or an action taken in pursuance of any provision or clause of the said Bye-laws shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of this Bye-law.

35. (i) **This Bye-Laws is recommended by the State Executive Committee in its meeting held on 13/09/2022 and approved by the State Council in its meeting held on 25/09/2022 respectively.**


(ii) **These Bye-Laws shall be effective from the date of approval of the Chief National Commissioner.**
