THE NAGALAND STATE BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES ASSOCIATION BYE-LAWS

- 1. NAME: The name of the State Association shall be called 'The Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides' Association.
- 2. SHORT TITLE: The Bye-Laws shall be called "The Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides Association Bye-Laws".
- 3. COMMENCEMENT: The Bye-Laws shall come into force from the date of approval by the Chief National Commissioner of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters, New Delhi.

4. DEFINITION:

- (4.1) 'Association' means the Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides.
- (4.2) 'Memorandum of Association' means the Memorandum of the Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides;
- (4.3) 'Rules' means the Rules of the Bharat Scouts and Guides;
- (4.4) Words and expressions used in these Bye-Laws shall, unless otherwise provided in the Bye-Laws, have the same meaning assigned to them in the Memorandum of Association and the Rules.

5. ADDRESS OF STATE ASSOCIATION:

The Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides, State Headquarters Office, Bayavü Hill, Kohima-797001, Nagaland.


6. MEMBERSHIP:

The Membership of the Association in the Local / District Association is open to all citizens of India; who subscribe to the Fundamentals, which includes the Purpose, the Principles, the Methods, the Promise and the Law.

Provided, a citizen of any other nationality residing for the time being in Nagaland may be admitted as a member of the Local / District Association with the approval of the State Chief Commissioner.

Provided, further, that such person pledges to the Scout or Guide Promise as hereunder:

"On my honor, I promise that I will do my best, to do my duty to God and India; to help other people; and to obey the Scout or Guide Law".



6.1 THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE ASSOCIATION SHALL CONSIST OF:

- I. All the Districts of the Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides.
- II. Existing Life Members of the State Association.
- III. Chairperson of the Local Association affiliated directly with the State in case of no district association in the district.
- IV. Group Leader of the group registered directly with the State Association in case of no District/Local Association in the District.
- V. Life Members are those who are admitted as such by the State Executive Committee and who have paid Life Membership Fee as prescribed.

 Life Membership will be open to those who are willing to abide by the fundamentals of the Bharat Scouts and Guides and pay the prescribed fees.

Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides will continue to use this to encourage members and others for financial help and increase in membership growth. Life Members will continue for lifetime.

Note V (a): From the date of approval of these new rules, no life members will be admitted.

Note V (b): Existing Life Members of State Association will confinue for lifetime.

Note:

- i. There will be no further individual membership at State Association and members are either elected, nominated or representative of District Association in the State Council.
- ii. Provided, however, the State Council shall have the power to act not withstanding any vacancy in the membership there of.
- iii. Provided, further, that any member of the State Council who is a member by virtue of office shall cease to be a member of the Council when he/she ceases to hold such office.
- iv. Provided, further that any member who representing the District Association cease to be the member of the State Council or Executive in case the District Council is dissolved.

6.2 TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

- If any member is found guilty of criminal offence, involving moral turpitude, his/her membership shall be terminated and any award/privilege shall be withdrawn.
- II. If any member of any unit/ Association/ District Council or state council while supporting any other Organization is found indulging in activities detrimental to the interests of the movement or bring disrepute to the organization by way of writings in publications/media (including social media) or confirmed propaganda against the interests of the movement/organization shall be liable to be terminated from the organization provided, due enquiry takes place and due opportunity is provided, to the persons(s) to be heard.
- III. If any member of the Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides is found to be a member of any Parallel organization working in the name of Scouting and Guiding or is found aiding and abetting the activities of such an organization, his/her membership of the Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides will be terminated.
- IV. If the member or office bearer of any association or council violates any provision(s) of the Code of Conduct as approved and revised periodically by State Executive Committee.

7 BOARD OF PATRONS:

There shall be a board of Patrons headed by the Chief Patron. The Honourable Governor of the State Nagaland may be invited to be the Chief Patron of the State Association. Honourable Chief Minister of state will be invited to be the Patron of the State Association. The Members of the Board of Patrons shall be invited preferably from Ministry of:

Youth Affairs and Sports

Education

Women and Child Welfare

Skill Development

Home Minister or any other Minister as may be decided by the State Executive Committee.

Vice-Patron: There may be one or more Vice Patrons who pay such contribution or donation as may be determined by the State Executive Committee, and are admitted as such by the State Executive Committee.

The President of the State Association may nominate some more leaders of the State with the information to the State Council.

8. STATE COUNCIL:

The State Council shall consist of:

- 1. The President;
- 2. One or more but not more than twelve Vice Presidents Six male(6) and six (6) female
- 3. The State Chief Commissioner;
- 4. The Immediate Past State Chief Commissioner;
- 5. The State Commissioner of Cub, Scout and Rover;
- 6. The State Commissioner of Bulbul, Guide and Ranger;
- 7. The State Commissioner of Scouts (Adult Resources) and Guides (Adult Resources)
- 8. The State Commissioners (Headquarters) (not more than 8)
- 9. The State Treasurer;
- 10. The State Secretary;
- 11. The Joint State Secretary;
- 12. The Assistant State Commissioners of Scouts;
- 13. The Assistant State Commissioners of Guides;
- 14. The State Organizing Commissioner of Scouts;
- 15. The State Organizing Commissioner of Guides;
- 16. The State Training Commissioner of Scouts;
- 17. The State Training Commissioner of Guides;
- 18. All the District Chief Commissioners or Divisional Chief Commissioner;
- 19. All District Commissioners or Divisional Commissioners;
- 20. All the Assistant District Commissioners in charge of Local Association where there is no District Association;
- 21. All Leader Trainers of Scouts holding valid Honourable Charges;
- 22. All Leader Trainers of Guides holding valid Honourable Charges;
- 23. All the District Secretaries:
- 24. All the Jt. District Secretaries;
- 25. All the Local Association Secretaries if there is no district association;
 - 26. Two young leaders below the age of 29 years co-opted by the President from among the members of the State Youth Committee on recommendation of State Chief Commissioner, one of whom shall be a woman;
 - 27. Special Invitees: The State Chief Commissioner may invite special invitees in consultation with the President of the State Association;
 - 28. One or more but not more than twenty members nominated by The President, BSG, State Association on the recommendation of State Chief Commissioner in consultation with the State Executive Committee, at least ten of whom shall be women.

The following individuals will be eligible for consideration as nominated member of the State Council:

- I. Volunteer leaders having not less than twenty years of active association with organization;
- II. Silver Elephant Awardees residing in the State;
- III. Donors who have donated one lakh or more to the State Association in the last three financial years provided they subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of the Movement as well as Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.
- IV. Professionals having not less than ten years experience in the field of Education, Administration, Literature, Finance, Law, Management, and Information Technology provided they subscribe to the Aims and Objectives of the Movement as well as Code of Conduct applicable to the members of the organization.

Note: Provided further, any National Office Bearers of the National Association residing in the state shall be invited as a Special Invitees in the State Council Meeting.

MEETINGS OF STATE COUNCIL

- A. Ordinary State Council Meeting: As per BSG Rule 62.1 to 62.3
- B. Special State Council Meeting: As per BSG Rule 62.4

9. NOMINATION OF PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT AND STATE CHIEF COMMISSIONER:

The Nagaland State Bharat Scouts and Guides hereby opt for nomination over election process. There shall be nomination by virtue of the post for President, Vice President and State Chief Commissioner as per rule of the BSG.

The State Council may invite -

- 1. For President: Honourable advisor / minister of YRS, Education or related Department .
- 2. For Vice President: Director of YRS, School Education, Higher Education and as decided and approved by the State Council according to the needs of the State.
- 3. For State Chief Commissioner: Chief Secretary or Commissioner and Secretary, Department of Youth Resources and Sports, Department of Education, Govt. of Nagaland or as decided by the State Council according to the needs of the State.

10. FINANCE COMMITTEE: As per BSG Rule 77.



11. STATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: AS PER BSG RULE 78

The State Executive Committee shall consist of:

- A. The State Chief Commissioner;
- B. The State Commissioner of Cub, Scout and Rover;
- C. The State Commissioner of Bulbul, Guide and Ranger;
- D. The State Commissioner of Scouts (Adult Resources) and Guides (Adult Resources)
- E. The State Commissioners Headquarters (not more than 8,04 from each wing)
- F. The State Treasurer:
- G. The State Secretary
- H. The Joint State Secretary;
- I. The Assistant State Commissioners of Scouts; (not more than 04)
- J. The Assistant State Commissioners of Guides; (not more than 04)
- K. The State Organizing Commissioner of Scouts;
- L. The State Organizing Commissioner of Guides;
- M. The State Training Commissioner of Scouts;
- N. The State Training Commissioner of Guides;
- O. All the District Chief Commissioners;
- P. All the Assistant District Commissioners in charge of Local Association where there is no District Association;
- Q. One Leader Trainer from each section and from each Division holding valid Honourable Charges; In case of Leader Trainers representative, if the number of Leader Trainers exceeding the limit, State Executive Committee may finalize the procedure of election.
- R. Chairperson and Co-chairperson of State Youth Committee.
- S. Assistant Director of the Region.
- T. All the Vice Presidents may be invited as a special invitee, provided further; The State Chief Commissioner may invite one or more to be the special invitees for the specific purpose.
- 12. No Professional of the State or District shall be eligible to participate in the election process.
- In ease of any dispute, the decision of the Chief National Commissioner will be final. 13.

- 14. This Bye-Law is recommended by State Executive Committee in its meeting held on 27° July 2021 and approved by the State Council in its meeting held on 27th August 2021 respectively. As per the directive, there were some clauses which were edited on 19th May 2022
- 15. In case any rule is silent, the BSG rule will be applicable.
- 16. These Bye Laws shall be effective from the date of approval of the Chief National Commissioner.
