How to Reach	=	From Howrah Railway Station Bus No. L238 is available get down at Doltala. From Sealdah Railway Station local trains are available upto Madhyamgram station and from Madhyamgram station by Auto to Ganganagar. Buses towards Barasat are also available from Sealdah Station and Babu Ghat (at Babu Ghat buses are available for Doltala – Bus No. <b>DN-17 and 79D</b> and get down at Doltala. From Doltala Cycle Van/Rickshaw/Auto are also available upto camp site. Who can Attend	:	Scouts/Guides between 14-17 and Rovers/Rangers between 15-25 years of age who have completed at least Rajya Puraskar Badge may be selected for participation.
Quota Allocation	:	Scouts-04, Rovers-04 Unit Leader -01 Guides-04, Rangers-04 Unit Leader -01. Total=18. (No additional participants will be accepted.)
Financial Assistance	:	National Headquarters will reimburse travel subsidy maximum @ Rs 550/- per head or actual whichever is less on production of train/Bus ticket.  Participants of Railway State are requested to utilize Railway Pass.

Programme & Activities	:	State Exposition - (Each State will expose their Festival, Crafts, Culture & Tradition,, Marriage, Food, Development of Scouting/Guiding activities, Topography, History, People & Tribes, Food habits, Costumes including dress, Jewellery, Language, Ceremonies etc.  Exhibition, Marriage of India, Festivals of India, Folk Song, Folk dance, Patriotic Song, Food Plaza, Integration March, Integration Game, Camp-Fire, Demonstration of Swachhta Abhiyan, etc. (Please ensure to depute participants well prepared to take part in these competitive activities)
