I am looking forward to your participation during the conference and I hope that you will sign up your Member Organisation to contribute to the side activities that we will be sharing with you soon.




Dates

THEME

The overarching theme for the WAGGGS Regional Conferences is inspired by Compass 2032, Together We Thrive.

Our vision is an equal world where all girls can thrive. By 2032 we will be a girl-led Movement where every and any girl feels confident to lead and empowered to create a better world together.

The 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference logo incorporates symbolic bodhi tree leaves.

The bodhi tree (ficus religiosa) can be found in many South East Asian countries. It is sometimes referred to as the wisdom tree or tree of awakening /enlightenment, as it is believed that Siddhartha Gautama, the important spiritual leader who became known as the Buddha, reached enlightenment while sitting under such a tree in 500 BCE in India.

In Thai, it is called "bai bo". Bai = leaf, bo = the abbreviated word for bodhi.

The leaf is associated with peace and happiness. Traditionally, Thai students try to catch a falling bodhi leaf before their exams, placing the caught leaf in their exam textbook to bring good luck.

It is fitting that the 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference logo connects to this regional tree. We hope the virtual gathering will bring new awakenings as to how we might thrive together, explore the Compass Conversations, share good practices and common challenges, and that this coming together may be a time of happiness for all participants.


WELCOME TO THAILAND!

The Kingdom of Thailand is located in South East Asia. Its neighbours include Myanmar, Laos, Cambodia and Malaysia. Beautiful beaches, valuable mangrove, fishing communities and important tourist destinations are found along the Gulf of Thailand and Andaman coastlines.

In the North, mountains and forests are home to various ethnic groups living side by side; while the Central Plains, fed by the major river the Chao Phraya, provide an important rice and agricultural area.

Thailand, formerly Siam, has a rich cultural history; deep understanding of local wisdom and interesting historical sites, several recognised by UNESCO World Heritage.





Today Bangkok is the capital city. Thailand has a constitutional Monarchy, under H.M. King Maha Vajiralongkorn, King Rama X who features on the bank notes. Thailand is home to over 70 million people. The Thai flag is a common site throughout the Kingdom. Red represents the land and people, White represents religion, which is predominantly Buddhism, and blue represents the monarchy. Thai people celebrate New Year in April with a festival known as Songkran.






INFORMATION ABOUT THE MEMBER ORGANISATION

Girl Guiding began in 1957, founded by Lady Kanok Samsen Vil. In 1963 GGAT was granted Royal Patronage by Her Majesty Queen Sirikit. Most guiding activities take place in schools throughout the country. The Association also offers opportunities in the non-formal education sector.

GGAT has regional centres and campsites but the headquarters, opened in 1967, is located in Bangkok. The HQ offers hostel accommodation for girls studying in Bangkok, guest accommodation, a swimming pool and cafeteria both open to the public.

GGAT enjoys service projects and cultural exchanges with many WAGGGS members.



SAVE THE DATE! YOUNG WOMEN'S PRE-EVENT

Asia Pacific Region will be hosting an online Young Women's Pre-Event on 6 and 7 August 2022. This will be an opportunity for young women to learn about WAGGGS global and regional governance; prepare for an impactful conference experience and connect with each other.

Thanks to the Juseon Byun Leadership Fund, the event will be free for young women to attend. More details will be available soon.

PLATFORM

The platform selected for the virtual 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference is EventsAIR. We might also deliver some of the sessions using Zoom.

With the EventsAIR platform, you will be able to find all the documents needed, connect and chat with other participants, and speak during the online sessions. Head Delegates will be able to conduct the voting within the same platform.



What you will need:

- A strong Wi-Fi or data connection
- A device (laptop/tablet/smartphone) with speakers and microphone
- The device should also have a camera if you wish to speak
- A headset or headphones will make it easier to speak and listen to other participants
- A setting where it is reasonably quiet to make it easier to capture all the information
- A pen and paper if you want to make notes during the sessions

You will receive a unique link to access the virtual Regional Conference, which must not be shared with anyone else, on social media or on any other public forum.

Further information about how to access and use the conference platform will be shared nearer to the conference. This will include written guidance as well as the opportunity to attend an online introduction session.



REGISTRATION

BOOK ONLINE THROUGH OUR WEBSITE!

Registration is now open for the 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference. Registrations can be completed online through the dedicated Conference website.

Registration is available in English. You can book more than one ticket at once, but you will be required to provide the information details for all the attendees. **Please note, you will need to use a unique email address for each of the attendees you register.** This is so all attendees will receive their individual link to join the 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference and be kept informed with updates.

OFFICIAL DELEGATIONS

Before registering, please send your MO's official delegation list to <u>AP.ReCo@wagggs.org</u>. This will speed up your registration approval process.

Your MO official delegation list should:

- be on MO headed paper and signed by the IC/CC.
- indicate who is the Head Delegate, Delegate and Observers.
- highlight the young women in the delegation.

WAGGGS will review all registrations and confirm roles outlined on the provided MO delegation list. Once your registration is confirmed, you will be sent a link to pay the registration fees online.

Each Full or Associate Member Organisation of WAGGGS in the Region is entitled to send two Delegates appointed from within its membership. The Delegates carry the authority of their Member Organisation to speak and vote on its behalf and are expected to participate in all proceedings.

In addition, Member Organisations may send up to 10 Observers who act in support of their Delegates.





REGISTRATION

YOUNG WOMEN

Are you a young woman who will be under the age of 30 on the first day of the Conference?

In support of WAGGGS' mission of developing young women as decision makers, Member Organisations should make every effort possible to include at least two young women (aged 18-30) in the delegation as either a conference delegate or observer. Young women who currently serve or are being developed as members of the national board, executive committee or sub-committees are ideal candidates to fulfil this role and will gain valuable international experience.

Thanks to the generous support of Friends of Asia Pacific WAGGGS, two young women from each MO can apply to attend the conference free of charge! This is available to MOs who are unable to fund their full delegation registration fees. To apply, please fill out the grant section of the registration form (more information is below).

Any young woman attending will get an attractive 30% discount to encourage attendance. Use the code **THRIVE2022** to enable this discount.

And don't forget to register your interest in attending the Young Women's Pre-Event from 6 – 7 August 2022. More details will be available soon.

GUESTS

If you would like to join us as a guest outside of an official delegation, your registration will be confirmed by the Regional Committee and then you will be sent a link to pay the registration fees online. Friends of Asia Pacific WAGGGS will receive detailed information about how they can register to join in the coming months.

GRANTS

GRANTS

Grants will be available to support Member Organisations to participate in the virtual 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference.

Recognising that a virtual conference potentially brings different barriers to attendance than a physical conference, the grants for the 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference can support representatives of Member Organisations with funding towards some of the following costs:

- accessing the conference platform (for example, internet connection, purchasing data)
- items of equipment where there is a demonstrated need (for example, headphones, laptop/device)
- access to/hire of a meeting room with good broadband internet connection
- registration fee for young women

When reviewing grant applications, the following criteria will be taken into account:

- Ensuring the Conference has a quorum
- Member Organisations otherwise not represented at Conference
- Young women aged under 30 on the first day of the Conference (August 10, 2022)

You can apply for a grant to participate in the virtual 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference when registering before **20 April 2022**. All applicant MOs will be informed of the outcome of their application before end of April 2022.

The allocation of grants will also be subject to the following conditions:

- The Member Organisation is not suspended and is up to date with membership fee payments i.e. has paid its 2021 membership fees.
- Grants cannot be transferred to another person. In exceptional circumstances, a Member Organisation may apply for a change of beneficiary. This should be done at least one month before the start of the conference.
- If the recipient of the grant does not attend the conference, the grant must be reimbursed in its entirety to WAGGGS.
- Feedback on the experience will be required at or after the conference in a format which will be confirmed at a later date.

There is also an opportunity to sponsor another Member Organisation, giving funds to their delegates for internet connection or equipment by making a contribution to the Asia Pacific Region. TELLERS

As part of the preparations for the 14th Asia Pacific Regional Conference, we are pleased to invite applications to be a Teller at the conference.

The Tellers will count and verify the results of each vote and report the results to the Conference Chair.

We are looking for enthusiastic individuals who:

- Are confident in using computers and digital technology;
- Are able to communicate in English both verbally and in writing;
- Offer a high-level of attention to detail and accuracy;
- Have a calm approach when under time-pressure.


Tellers must be available during the week of the Regional Conference and will also need to attend orientation sessions and rehearsals which will take place in the month before the conference.

Those appointed as Tellers will be given training in how to use the conference platform but previous experience of online events and/or electronic voting would be beneficial.

Those attending the conference as a Head Delegate or Delegate for their Member Organisation cannot undertake the role of Teller.
