SUB: FORMATION OF NATIONAL YOUTH COMMITTEE-reg.

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that as per the nomination submitted by the State Associations, the National Youth Committee of the Bharat Scouts and Guides is formed with immediate effect. **The list of nominated members to the National Youth Committee is enclosed herewith.** This National Youth Committee will function for the existing terms of the National Council i.e. 2021-2026.

Further, States like Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh has not submitted the latest list of Chairperson & Co-Chairperson of the State Youth Committee till date as invited vide NHQ Circular No 168/2021 dated 08/12/2021. Hence, the eligible youth of previous National Youth Committee of these States are retained in the existing National Youth Committee so that these State Association will not go unrepresented and the youth may get an opportunity to expose in the National Youth Committee. This matter was already informed to the members who attended the Meeting of the National Programme & Training Committee held at NHQ from 29-31 March, 2022. If State wants replacement, fresh names (Chairperson & Co-Chairperson of the State Youth Committee) to be submitted to NHQ and will be replaced accordingly.

The State who has not submitted the list of their State Youth Committee Chairperson and Co-Chairperson are requested to forward the same along with duly filled proforma as attached in NHQ Circular No. No 168/2021 dated 08/12/2021 at the earliest but not later than **25th April, 2022 and empower young people in the decision making process through the National Youth Committee and represent the State Association.**

After 25th April, 2022, if there is any un-represented State, Hon'ble Chief National Commissioner in exercising the powers vested under Chapter I of the Rules Book of the Bharat Scouts and Guides rules No. 40 will nominate the young members as deemed fit in the National Youth Committee and any objection raised to this issue by the State will not be entertained.

Please communicate the nominated youth to regularly join the meeting of the National Youth Committee organized virtually or physically.
