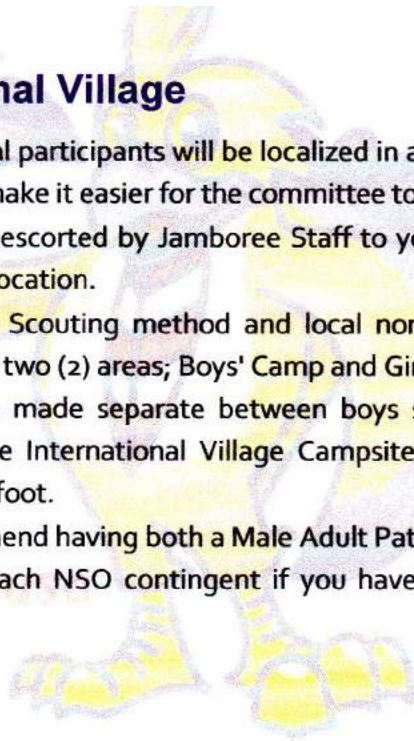


International Village

- International participants will be localized in an area that we call the 'International Village' to make it easier for the committee to monitor and provide services.
- You will be escorted by Jamboree Staff to your campsite when you arrive at the Jamboree Location.
- Due to our Scouting method and local norm, the Jamboree Campsite will be divided into two (2) areas; Boys' Camp and Girl Camps. So the International Village will also be made separate between boys scout and girl scouts. The distance between the International Village Campsite for boys and girls is only about 5 minutes on foot.
- We recommend having both a Male Adult Patrol Leader and a Female Adult Patrol Leader in each NSO contingent if you have both Boys and Girls Scout in your contingent

Meals Service

- Ready-to-eat meals will be provide for dinner on the arrival date of August 12, 2022
- The committee will prepare (ready-to-cook) food ingredients for breakfast from August 13 to August 21 2022, which the Scouts themself must prepare.
- Shared Kitchens and Dining Tents will be set up in the International Village for every 16-20 Scouts (which may consist of more than 1-2 NSO) and defined as a dining group.
- Each Scout from the Dining Group, assisted by the Adult Patrol Leader, will take turns cooking for the group.
- All Jamboree foods are prepared to meet the appropriate standards of the Food Authority and are guaranteed HALAL.
- If any of the participants have allergies or specific dietary needs, please tell your LO, and they will follow up with Food Department.
- Each participant must bring personal eating utensils. Do not use other people's utensils.

Jamboree Program

Jamboree Activities will be carried out 80% inside the main camp and 20% outside the main camp. All the program will be carried out through educational, recreational, creative, productive, innovative, competitive and challenging approaches, taking into account the Basic Principles and Scouting Methods.
