18TH NATIONAL JAMBOREE OF THE BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES

❖ **DATES**

04TH TO 10TH JANUARY, 2023

❖ **THEME**

“PROGRESS WITH PEACE”

❖ **VENUE**

RIICO (DMIC) Area, NH-62. Rohat, District: Pali, Rajasthan State

❖ **REGISTRATION FEE**

Rajasthan State Bharat Scouts and Guides has decided not to charge any Jamboree Registration Fee from the Jamboree participants.

❖ **CONTRIBUTION TO SCOUT/GUIDE WELFARE FUND AS PER NHQ POLICY**

The decision of the National Executive Committee will be communicated in the next circular.

❖ **ELIGIBILITY**

Scout & Guide between the age of 13 to 17 years and having completed at least Dwitiya Sopan Badge led by Adult Leaders in the ratio of 9:1

❖ **FORMATION OF CONTINGENT**

The usual pattern of formation of Patrol as per APRO will be followed in accordance with Quota allotted.

❖ **HOW TO PARTICIPATE**

State contingent will send information of participation as per quota allotted to them to the Jamboree Secretary by email at jamboreeoffice@bsgindia.org with a copy to the Director, BS&G, NHQ, at jamboree@bsgindia.org stating composition of contingent as per Performa attached.

❖ **WHAT TO BRING**

CONTINGENT KIT:

1. Two Association Flag (One for hoisting and another for March Past).
2. Two Name Plates of State size 16" x 9" - White back ground with red letters in capital
3. Colour Party material as per Drill and March Past/APRO Part- I
4. Band Display, if any.
5. Equipment for activities to display and demonstration of Global Development Village, Exhibition, Physical Display, Pioneering Project, Skill O Rama, Integration March, Integration Game, Food Plaza, State Day Celebration and other competitions
6. Necessary Costumes, Musical Instruments for Folk-Dance and Camp fire etc.
7. First Aid and Medicine of personal requirements
8. Kitchen gears and all required materials for the Contingent.



❖ **INDIVIDUAL KIT**

Two sets of Correct and Complete Scout/ Guide uniform as per A.P.R.O Part-II &III,, Sleeping bag, Ruck Sack, Torch, Water bottle, Compass, Personal requisites, Plate, Mug, Spoon and other equipment necessary for participation in Integration / fun / adventure / intellectual activities.

❖ **CAMP KIT**

Buckets, Utensils for cooking, Durries (Ground sheets), Gadget materials, Decoration material, Camp tools, Hurricane etc.

❖ **ACTIVITIES**

The Jamboree will be full of challenging activities with plenty of enjoyment for Scouts and Guides as per the Jamboree programme given below.

❖ **STATE LEVEL ACTIVITIES (WING WISE)**

Group activities (Wing wise) State Gate, Camp Craft, Campfire, Rangoli (Guide), Pioneering Project.(Scout)

❖ **COMMON STATE LEVEL ACTIVITIES (JOINT FOR BOTH THE WINGS)**

Group Activities (Joint for both the wings)

March Past, Colour Party, Folk Dance, Physical Display, Band Display, State Exhibition, State Day (Exposition), Pageant Show, Global Development Village.

❖ **JUDGING SYSTEM**

A Panel of Judges at the State Level will Judge Group Activities.

Grade Certificate with pennant will be presented to those states, which are achieving Grade- A in the above subjects.

- The State achieving highest marks in group activities in each wing will be awarded Chief Commissioner's Shield.
- The States achieving highest marks in Joint Group activities will be awarded Chief National Commissioner's Flag.

Note: - Details of the activities will be given in the Jamboree Bulletin No.2.

❖ **ACCOMMODATION**

One Tent will be provided for every 9+ 1 Scouts & 9 + 1 Guides i.e. (One Patrol along with adult leader)

Extra tents will be kept for Contingent Leader, State supporting staff, and Quarter Master.

Jamboree will be divided in two parts (1) Scout Wing (2) Guide Wing. Separate accommodation will be provided to the Scout and Guides in the Camps. We assure adequate water supply and sanitation arrangements in the Jamboree.

❖ **FOOD ARRANGEMENT**

Kitchen area will be provided for cooking in each Sub- Camp. We encourage both wings to cook and dine separately. Joint cooking will not be allowed. In case of Joint Cooking, the State must inform on or before 30.09.2022 to the Jamboree Secretary by email at jamboreeoffice@bsgindia.org with a copy to NHQ at jamboree@bsgindia.org

❖ **FACILITIES**

- (i) Bank will function in the Jamboree site.
- (ii) A well- equipped hospital with qualified doctors and nurses and dispensary facility will be available at the Jamboree site. 24x7 Ambulance services will also be available in the Jamboree ground. Contingents are requested to come prepared with First Aid material to cater to the needs of the members of the contingent for the journey period.
- (iii) Store in the market for supply of Gas Cylinder/Fire wood/groceries /vegetable, Milk etc. will be opened.
- (iv) Internet Café will also be made available in the Sub-Camps.

❖ **TRANSPORT**

Local Transportation facility will be made available from Jodhpur/Loni / Rohat& Pali Railway Station/ Bus Station & Airport to Jamboree site on payment in nominal cost. Rates/Charges of Bus fare/Tempo/Truck will be communicated shortly.

❖ **SIGHT SEEING**

On demand of the States, Buses will also be arranged by the host State for sightseeing on payment.

❖ **QUOTA**

As per sheet attached. This quota will not be increased further. If your state confirmation is not received by 31.08.2022, the quota will be allotted to any other needy state.

❖ **REPORTING**

All the contingent must report latest by 10.00 A.M. on 03.01.2023. Late comers may not get representation in the Opening Ceremony.

❖ **RELIEVING**

10.01.2023 after Lunch

State Associations are requested to prepare well in advance for high standard performance in the programmes & activities in the Jamboree and to make 18th National Jamboree a grand success and a memorable one.
