Name	:	Virtual observation of the International Day of Peace (IDP) 2021 at National Level.
Date & Time	:	18 th to 21 st September 2022 from 15:00 - 17:00 hrs (IST) (03:00 to 05:00P.M)
Mode of Webinar	:	Zoom Cloud Meeting
Activities	:	Youth-led action through Messengers of Peace; Scouts for SDGs; Earth Tribe Initiative; Scouts for Humanitarian Action; Observation of International Day of Peace (IDP) 2022 - Talk on the theme: " End racism. Build peace " and young members of BSG will present – Peace Video Clip, Dialogue for Peace, Report from Scout MoP Reporter, BSG in Peace Initiatives etc.

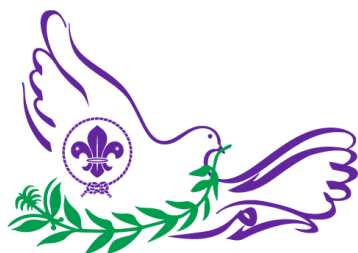
Who can Participate	: Open to members of BSG members i.e. Cubs-Bulbuls, Scouts-Guides, Rovers-Rangers & Unit Leaders. Open to Non-Scouts also. Appreciation Letter only will be issued to non-Scout who participate regularly.
Initiatives on SDGs	: Members of BSG may share the initiatives taken at her/his level towards SDGs through a video presentation. The file Format should be in MP4/SIZE. The file should not exceed more than 100 MB, with a recording of 640×480 Pixel Frame. Duration of the Video Uploaded for selection round should be of less than 05 minutes consisting of 30 Seconds for the Self Introduction. Selected Members will be called for the presentation about her/his initiative during the webinar.
Messengers of Peace	: Members of BSG (open to non-Scouts too) may share the initiatives taken at her/his level to spread peace actions in the community through a video presentation. The file Format should be in MP4/SIZE. The file should not exceed more than 100 MB, with a recording of 640×480 Pixel Frame/ Duration of the Video Uploaded for selection round should be of less than 05 minutes, consisting of 30 Seconds for the Self Introduction. Selected Members will be called for the presentation about her/his initiative during the webinar.
Dialogue for Peace	: Members of BSG (open to non-Scouts too) may share the best Dialogue for Peace. Selected member will get an opportunity to present his/her topic in the webinar.
Report from Scout MoP Reporter	: As MoP " Reporter " BSG members may interview non-Scouts and community Leaders with video recording to raise awareness about the theme and share your video

Certificate	: National Level Digital Certificate will be presented to the registered participant. Certificate will be issued to members having valid BSG UID (i.e. who have registered in OYMS) and who have submitted feedback

	form. Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger and Adult Leader who is selected for presentation in the webinar will be recognized.
Last Date	: Online Registration closes on 10th September 2022 (midnight) .

Link to upload the videos will be shared with the registered participants who registers in the above link on Youth-led action through **Messengers of Peace; Scouts for SDGs; Earth Tribe Initiative; Scouts for Humanitarian Action; Observation of International Day of Peace (IDP) 2022** etc.
