<b>Date of Arrival</b>	:	<b>19<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 before lunch.</b>
<b>Date of Departure</b>	:	<b>23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2023 after lunch.</b>
<b>How to Reach</b>	:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>❖ Gadpuri is situated on the Mathura road in between Palwal and Ballabgarh (just 10 km from Ballabgarh). From SaraiKalen Khan Buses are available for Palwal. Get down at Gadpuri bus stand.</li><li>❖ Nearest Metro Station is Raja Nahar Singh (Ballabgarh) in Violet line. Direct Metro Train service is available from Kashmiri Gate/ Mandi House/ Central Secretariat.</li><li>❖ Raja Nahar Singh (Ballabgarh) to Gadpuri share auto are available.</li></ul>
<b>Registration Fund</b>	:	<b>180/- per head</b> is to be deposited during registration being the Scout/Guide Welfare Fund by each participant i.e. Scout/Guide/ Rover/Ranger and <b>Rs. 280/- per head</b> for Adult Leaders.
<b>Who can Participate</b>	:	Scouts/Guides between 14-17 and Rovers/Rangers between 15-25 years of age who have completed at least Rajya Puraskar Badge may be selected for participation.
<b>Quota Allocation</b>	:	Scouts-04, Rovers-04 Unit Leader-01 Guides-04, Rangers-04 UnitLeader-01. <b>Total=18 (No additional participants will be accepted.)</b>
<b>Financial Assistance</b>	:	<b>National Headquarters will reimburse travel subsidy maximum @ Rs 550/- per head or actual whichever is less on production of train/Bus ticket subject to receipt of Grant in Aid from the Govt. of India</b> <b>Participants of Railway State are requested to utilize Railway Pass.</b>

<b>Programme &amp; Activities</b>	: <b>State Exposition</b> - (Each State will expose their Festival, Crafts, Culture & Tradition, Marriage, Food, Development of Scouting/Guiding activities, Topography, History, People & Tribes, Food habits, Costumes including dress, Jewellery, Language, Ceremonies etc. <b>Exhibition, Marriage of India, Festivals of India, Folk Song, Folk dance, Patriotic Song, Food Plaza, Integration Game, Camp-Fire, Demonstration of Swachhta Abhiyan, Camp fire etc. (Please ensure to depute participants well prepared to take part in these competitive activities)</b>
<b>What to bring</b>	: <b>INDIVIDUAL KIT:</b> Two sets of correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part II & III, Toilet requisites, Personal dress, Warm Bedding, Traditional Costumes for Cultural Programmes and Camp-Fire, requisite materials for State Exhibition and State Exposition, Materials for Food Plaza etc. <b>CONTINGENT KIT :</b> ( 1) Contingent Utensils (Patila), Bucket, Donga, Tasla, Serving Spoon, Kettle, Mug etc. for receiving Contingent meals from the Central Mess. (2) State Pla-Card. (3) Materials for State Exposition and Exhibition. (4) Materials for Food plaza (Cooking utensils, raw provisions, stove etc. (5) Traditional Costumes like dress for Song, Dance, Festival, Marriage, Exhibition, Camp-Fire etc. (6) Musical Instrument as per the need of the State. (7) If any dance is to be performed on audio/Music <b>(Own Lap-Top or Record Player is preferred)</b>
