We are excited to announce the launch of the BSG Short Film-Making competition, to be organised by the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters. We would like to invite all the members of the organisation to participate in the competition. The competition is based on the theme of "Climate Action, SDG – 13 and how our youth is contributing to create a better India".

BSG members, who are above 13 years of age, individuals or Unit from anywhere in the country can participate in the competition. The competition is open to non-Scouts/Guides also, but they must collaborate with a Scout/ Guide unit/group to complete the project.

Participants are expected to create a short film within 5 to 8 minutes. The film should be in any language (if it is other than English/Hindi must have English subtitles), original and based on the theme. It should focus on the ways in which our youth are contributing towards creating a better India by taking climate action and working towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. The entries will be judged on the basis of creativity, originality, content, technical aspects and the message conveyed by the film. Any soundtrack or music used for the production of the film must be royalty free or with paid royalty rights or from original authorship.

The top three winners will be awarded cash prizes of Rs.5000/-, Rs.3000/-, and Rs.2000/-respectively.

The deadline for submission of entries is **30**<sup>th</sup> **April 2023**. All films should be submitted through an online Google form only. Please attach the Google Drive Open link in Google Form of your video, along with a short biography of the filmmaker, as well as a brief synopsis of your film (not more than 100 words) to be sent during the submission of videos. Applicant sends the video by filling online Google form in the below-mentioned link on or before 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023.
