The Director will identify the projects for the Intern's assignment upon receiving the applications from State Association/Individual or from Institutions.
Commencement	:	Any executive/intern should begin the assignment only after they have agreed to the guidelines and the conditions on the Programme.
Reports	:	 Upon completion of the assignment, the executive/intern shall submit a brief summary report including an evaluation on the prescribed form, before departure from the base location. The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters will also send performance report of the interns to the
Location on	:	sponsoring State Association/ Institution. Internship assignments will take place both at the NHQ
Language requirement	:	Office and in the field as per the demand of the project. The working language will be both Hindi and English. Therefore, Interns shall be fluent in spoken and written English/Hindi.
Type of Assignment	:	The work is desk based on site or field work. It will include project formulation, monitoring and/ or evaluation, research and preparation.
