3. Photographs:

- A selection of high-resolution photographs capturing the essence of the activities, events, and training conducted.
- Each photograph should be accompanied by a caption describing the context and significance.

Please note the following instructions:

1. The report can be submitted in either English or Hindi or both languages.
2. The report should be compiled in an electronic format (PDF and Word document) for easy dissemination and archival purposes.
3. The photographs should be submitted as separate files in JPEG or PNG format, labeled clearly with the corresponding captions.

We kindly request that the consolidated report from each state reaches the BSG National Headquarters by June 10, 2023. This will allow us ample time to compile and finalize the Annual Report.

We sincerely appreciate your prompt and positive response to this request. Your contributions are invaluable in showcasing the tremendous impact of the Bharat Scouts and Guides on youth development.
