Place of attraction	<p>:  Nalanda University: Nalanda University Archaeological Complex is the excavated site of the ancient university. It is spread over an area of 14 hectares and is a major place of tourist attraction.</p> <p>Hiuen Tsang: Built as a dedication to the Chinese scholar Hiuen Tsang, this memorial is a distinct reminder of the architectural style of the Nalanda University. </p> <p> Pawapuri: A holy pilgrimage for Jains, Pawapuri is an important destination located in the Nalanda district. Its history dates back more than 2600 years ago and is famous for being the burial site for Lord Mahavira.</p> <p>Nalanda Archaeological Museum: Housing the ancient relics of Nalanda University, this museum offers a glance into the culture of ancient Nalanda. Pala Art is displayed through the assorted artifacts maintained here. </p> <p> Rajgir: Rajgir is town where the air that surrounds its beautiful sceneries carries hints of spirituality and vibrant hues of history with links with both Buddhism and Jainism.</p>
