The Details of the Event as follows:

Name of the Event	:	Regional Level Cub Bulbul Utsav.
Purpose	:	The purpose of the Cub Bulbul Utsav is to provide a platform to the Cubs and Bulbuls to develop their confidence and expose him/her self through games and fun.
Date	:	25 th to 29 th April 2023.
Venu	:	State Training Centre Tanhril, Aizawl, Mizoram
How to reach	:	From Aizawl bus stand, shared taxis are available for the campsite on reasonable rates to reach STC, Tanhril. https://goo.gl/maps/dCCaHcQBxfJdFJfh8
Reporting	:	25 th April (before lunch).
Departure	:	29 th April (After Lunach).
Sucot Guide Welfare Fund	:	Rs. 2000/- (Two Thousands) per head for Cub-Bulbul & Unit Leader to be paid at the time of Registration.
Subsidy	:	Subsidy @ Rs. 70/- per head per day (Rs. 70 x 5 = Rs. 350.00) and travelling expenses @ Rs. 550/- or actual whichever is less will be reimbursed on receipt of Government Grant. Participants of Railway State are requested to utilize Railway Pass.
Quota	:	As attached annexure No. - 01.
Who can Participate	:	Cubs / Bulbuls between the age of 7 to 10 years and completed Tritya Charan / Swarna Pankh are eligible to attend the Utsav.
What to bring	:	Following materials are must to be carried by each Participant: Two sets of correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part-II/III, Clothing, Warm Bedding, Umbrella/Raincoat, Costume for cultural items (Red Flower & Kalarav), Materials for Totem Pole, Costumes for Tara Story/ Jungle Dance, Wings for Bulbul Ring, white frock with white socks and ribbons for bulbuls, Plate, Glass, Spoon, Mug, Toilet requisites, Candle, Water-Bottle, Torch, Pen, Note Book, Writing Materials, Materials for Handicraft, Drawing and Paintings, Paper Cutting etc.

Activities / Programmes	:	Following programme and activities will be organized in the Cub Bulbul Utsav. All participants should come prepared with their costumes and musical instruments. They should bring the materials for exhibition and other competitions to participate in these programme and activities. Cub /Bulbul Greetings, Jungle Dance / Tara Story, Exhibition, Bulbul Tree, totem pole, Story Telling, Play Acting, Model Making, Paper Cutting, Drawing, Painting, craft model, Group Song, Group Dance, Food Plaza Red Flower, Kalrav etc. Materials requires for the above activities must be brought by the Participants.
Weather	:	average high-temperature of 26.8°C (80.2°F) and an average low-temperature of 17.5°C (63.5°F).
Last Date	:	The list of selected candidates should reach at the Bharat Scouts and Guides, Central Regional Headquarters at adner@bsgindia.org with a copy to State Secretary Mizoram at bsg_miz@yahoo.co.in on or before 30th March 2023 along with arrival & departure itinerary of the participants. Please note: If we fail to receive confirmation by 20th March, 2023 additional quota will be allotted to other needy States. Hence, your state will miss the opportunity.
