WEATHER:	During February Pachmarhi will be cold and the temperature the area will be around 2 to 18 degree. Hence sufficient war clothes are to be brought accordingly.
HOW TO REACH	Pachmarhi is known as Queen of Satpura, one of the hill station in Madhya Pradesh. The nearest Railway station is PIPARIYA which is one-hour journey from Itrasi Junction towards Jabalpu (about 3 hour's journey from Jabalpur towards Itarsi) in Itars Allahabad Railway line. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi 56 km. The bust stand at Pipariya is just outside the Pipariya Railway Station. Transport buses are available. Numbers or private jeeps are also available on nominal rates from Pachamra bus stand to our Institute which is just 5 km away from bustand. From Bhopal to Pachmarhi, 6 hours journey by road.
