| Eligibility | : | Commissioners or full-time Professionals responsible or in charge of Youth Programme; and/or young people between the age of 18 to 26 who have actively been involved with community projects and work related to the sustainable development goals. |
| Registration Fee | : | US\$250.00 per participant which cover inland transportation, meals, accommodation for the forum duration, forum kit, documents, and souvenirs. |
| Accommodation | : | Accommodation of summit participants will be taken care of from the night of 14 June 2023 until morning of 19 June 2023 (5 nights) and any extra nights will be at the cost of the participant/s. Participants will be accommodated in a room sharing basis. |

| Working Language | : | The working language of the summit will be English. Participants who are able to understand and take an active part in discussions in English can apply. The medium of instructions and inputs will also be in English. |
| Caution Money | : | Rs. 10,000/- (Non-refundable) if selected and not participated and adjusted after participation. Selected candidates will have to pay Rs. 1000/- as administrative charges and Rs. 2500/- towards Scout/Guide welfare fund which will be adjusted from caution money and balance amount is refundable after submission of event report to NHQ with adjustment if any. Caution money is to be remitted through the following link https://bit.ly/3qW5L3h and has to produce bank transfer receipt to authenticate the payment made along with application form. |
| Air Fare & VISA | : | Candidate is free to book his/her VISA and Air ticket at their own. If required NHQ will support ticketing & VISA through official travel agent on advance payment. |
| Last Date of Application | : | As the quota is limited, selection will be on the basis of "First Come First Serve" The application of the deserving candidate should reach the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters, New Delhi on or before 28th February, 2023 along with caution money Rs. 10,000/-, Scanned copy of valid passport and deposit/pay-in-slip is to be attached with the application to authenticate the caution money transfer. Brief details will be provided in the selection letter as soon as application form and caution money is received. |

State Associations are requested to encourage adult leaders and young people age 18 to 26 years and recommend their applications in the prescribed proforma (enclosed) to the National Headquarters, Bharat Scouts and Guides, New Delhi latest by **28th February, 2023**.
