### **SUB: SCOUTING FOR LIFE JAMBOREE AT HONG KONG**

We are glad to inform you that the Scout Association of Hong Kong is hosting the "Scouting for Life" Jamboree to be held from 6 to 10 April 2023. The Jamboree will be held at Pillar Point Valley, Tuen Mun. A series of exciting and challenging activities will be available to the campers. Details of the Jamboree are as under:

Name of the Event	:	Scouting for Life Jamboree
Date	:	06 <sup>th</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> April, 2023 (Thursday to Monday, 5 Days 4 Nights)
Date of Arrival	:	Participants are expected to arrive in the morning of April 2023 (Thursday)
Date of Departure	:	Evening of 10 <sup>th</sup> April 2023 (Monday)
Venue	:	Pillar Point Valley, Tuen Mun
Eligibility	:	Scout/Guide aged between 12 to 26 Years and adult leaders aged 18 or above. Each patrol should consist of 9 Scout members and 1 adult leader. <b>(All Leaders must obtain the certificate of the "Safe from Harm" online learning course.)</b>
Jamboree Fee	:	<b>USD200 per person (for both Scout members and adult leaders)</b> The cost covers inland transportation between the Hong Kong International Airport and Jamboree site, regular meals during Jamboree, camper handbook, Jamboree emblem, cap, scarf and certificate of participation.
Caution Fee	:	Rs. 10,000/- Non-refundable if selected and not participated and adjustable after participation. Caution Money is to be remitted through the following link under International Events <a href="http://bit.ly/3Xdh3z5">http://bit.ly/3Xdh3z5</a> Selected candidate will have to pay Rs. 1000/- as administrative charges, Rs. 2500/- towards Scout/Guide welfare fund and Rs. 1500/- for Magazine which will be adjustable from Caution Money and balance amount is refundable after submission of workshop report to NHQ.
Equipment to bring	:	Participants should bring along their personal camping equipment including tent, sleeping bag and mat, eating utensils, flashlight, rain-wear and

		sportswear. A more comprehensive equipment list will be provided to participants in due course.
Weather	:	Average temperature in April is around 20°C - 25°C.
Airfare & VISA	:	Candidate is free to book his/her air ticket at their own to and fro Hong Kong and back. If required, NHQ will support ticketing & VISA.
Last Date of Application	:	Preference will be given on " <b>First Come First Serve basis</b> " to the deserving candidate only. Application of the interested candidate should reach National Headquarters, New Delhi on or before <b>25/02/2023</b> along with a photocopy of valid passport and caution money duly recommended by the State Association.

State Associations are requested to encourage and promote participants and submit the name of the interested & deserving candidate to the National Headquarters on or before **25<sup>th</sup> February, 2023** along with the application form, caution money and photopage of valid passport.
