### **SUB: ASIA-PACIFIC REGIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING COURSE - 2024**

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that Bangladesh Scouts is hosting the second Asia-Pacific Regional Youth Leadership Training Course from 24 – 27 June 2024.

This training course aims to build high performing teams at all levels in Scouting, as well as develop young people to be more effective leaders in their communities. Thus, this training course enables young people to gain discerning knowledge; acquire technical and leadership skills; and develop appropriate attitude, through a collaborative, and activity-based environment.

Moreover, this training course is organized and led by the Asia-Pacific Regional Youth Representatives (RYRs) – by young people and for young people.

Details of the training course are as under:

Date	:	24 <sup>th</sup> to 27 <sup>th</sup> June, 2024
Arrival	:	23 <sup>rd</sup> June, 2024
Departure	:	28 <sup>th</sup> June, 2024
Venue	:	National Scout Training Center in Mouchak, Gazipur, Bangladesh. The camp is about 30 kilometres away from Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport (DAC) International Airport and may take more than one hour to reach. It is advisable if participants can arrive in the morning till afternoon to avoid late night or travelling during dawn.

Eligibility	<p>Nominated candidate should be aged between 18 to 25 years old at the time of the event, preferably:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rajya Puraskar/Rashtrapati Rover Scout</li> <li>• Fluent in speaking &amp; writing English</li> <li>• Active member of the State/District Association</li> <li>• Since quota is limited preference will be given to the deserving candidate as "<b>First Come First Serve Basis</b>"</li> </ul>

Course Fee	<p><b>USD200.00 per person</b></p> <p>This will include inland transportation from the airport to the venue and return, accommodation in sharing basis (check-in on 23 June and check-out on 28 June), food (from dinner of 23 June until breakfast of 28 June), and course materials. The fee can be deposited directly in the venue during registration.</p>
Travel Option	<p>Participants can travel by any mode of Transportation at their own. The cheapest mode to travel is by train</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Train services are available from Howrah &amp; New Jalpaiguri Railway station upto Dhaka. Bus services also available from Kolkata to Dhaka.</li> </ul>

Working Language	:	The working language of the training will be English. States are requested to recommend participants who can understand and take an active part in discussions in English.
Last Date of Registration	:	As the quota is limited, preference will be on the basis of ' <b>First Come First Serve</b> ' the application duly recommended by the state Association should reach NHQ, New Delhi on or before <b>30/04/2024</b> along with photocopy of valid passport and copy of the deposit/pay-in-slip.

State Association are requested to forward the names of interested and deserving candidates to the National Headquarters on or before 30/04/2024 as per the eligibility criteria along with caution money and photopage of valid passport. Late receipt of applications will not be entertained. Selection of deserving candidate entirely lies in the discretion of the National Headquarters.
