Scout-Guide Welfare Fund	:	<p>Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) per head for Rover, Ranger and Unit Leader to be paid at the time of Registration.</p>
Financial Assistance	:	<p>Free hospitality will be provided during the event. National Headquarters will reimburse food subsidy @ Rs. 350/- per head and travel subsidy maximum @ Rs 550/- per head or actual whichever is less on the production of train/Bus ticket. Participants of Railway State are requested to utilize Railway Pass.</p>
What to bring	:	<p>One set of correct and complete uniforms as per APRO Part - II/III, Light Bedding preferably a sleeping mat and bed sheet, Toilet requisites, Personal clothing, Traditional Costumes for Cultural Programme and Camp Fire, Plate, Glass, Notebook, Pen, colour/sketch pens for competitions, Torch, Water Bottle etc.</p>
Free Literature	:	<p>Free Literature or Scout-Guide Equipment of Rs. 100/- will be given to the registered participants.</p>
Activities	:	<p>Participants will engage in discussions, activities and practical sessions aimed at deepening their understanding of climate change and equipping them with the knowledge and skills to take meaningful action. Together, we will explore innovative strategies for mitigating the impact of climate change and fostering sustainability in our communities. Activities like Eco-Friendly Art Projects, Nature Walks, Environmental Cleanup, Waste Reduction Challenges, Carbon Footprint, Community Outreach, Demonstration on Hand Washing, Reel Making Competitions, Theme-based Campfire etc. will be conducted.</p>

If your State is not utilizing the allotted quota, please inform us at the earliest so that additional quota may be allotted to other states.</p>
