Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

This is to inform you that the Jamboree on the Air – Jamboree on the Internet (JOTA-JOTI) is an event that enables Scouts and Guides from all over the World to meet, even though they might not be in the same geographical location.

JOTA-JOTI, the world's largest annual digital event for Scouts and Guides, occurs every October, connecting millions of young people globally for a weekend of online activities promoting friendship and global citizenship. This event fosters 21st - century skill development through engaging group activities over the Internet and amateur radio, open to Scouts and Guides worldwide.

In 2024, JOTA-JOTI is scheduled from October 19th to 20th, featuring diverse non-formal educational programs like webinars, campfires, talent shows, and live performances. World Scouting's partners actively contribute to the event. Its mission is to educate participants of all ages on communication technology, global citizenship, and collaborative solutions for pressing global challenges.

Who can participate?

Cubs/Bulbuls, Scouts/Guides, Rovers/Rangers and Adult Leaders of any age can participate in JOTA-JOTI. (The amateur radio stations normally need to be operated by licensed amateur radio operations).

When?

JOTA-JOTI is an annual event that takes place during the third weekend of October and this year we are celebrating on **19th and 20th October 2024.**

JOTA-JOTI 2024

JOTA-JOTI 2024, the world's largest digital Scout and Guide event held annually in October, unites over 2 million young Scouts and Guides from more than 173 countries for a weekend of Scouting, Guiding, and global friendship.

Keeping young people [Safe from Harm](#) online is an important aspect of this event. This educational gathering focuses on communication technology learning, employing chat moderation, "listening ears," e-learning courses, and informative sessions to ensure a positive and inclusive experience while prioritizing online safety for all participants.

How do you get involved?

JOTA-JOTI is about the 21st-century skills you can learn in Scouting and Guiding and the values of global citizenship. The event is open to Scouts and Guides around the world, enabling young people to connect and communicate with each other using the Internet and amateur radio. JOTA-JOTI engages youth in educational activities that build teamwork, cross-cultural understanding and skills for the future.
