How to reach & Contact Person	:	Train 🚂: Trains are available upto Dehradun Railway Station. From Dehradun Railway Station the camp site is approximately 15 KMS. From Dehradun Railway Station Buses service are limited and runs on a fixed schedule that are available upto Raipur Chowk and from Raipur Chowk one has to take Tata magic/Vikram (small van) to reach Maldevta the camp site Or one can hire direct auto rickshaw from Dehradun Railway station to the camp site. By Air ✈️: The camp site is approximately 22 KMS from the Jolly Grant Airport and one can take Taxi/local public transportation to reach the venue. <p>Who can participate</p>	<p>: Rover/Ranger & Young Unit Leaders between 15 to 45 years of age, completed at least Nipun stage in Rovering / Rangering and at least Basic Trained Unit Leader and having sound health may be selected according to the quota allocation to the State. Each selected candidate has to submit Physical Fitness Certificate from the appropriate authority. The unfit candidate should not be selected. Risk certificate is to be submitted by all.</p>
<p>Contribution to Scout/Guide Welfare fund</p>	<p>: Total ₹2500/- (Two Thousand Five Hundred only) per head is to be remitted in the undermentioned Bank Account of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters. <p>Financial Assistance</p>	<p>: On receipt of Grant-In-Aid from the Government of India Food subsidy @Rs.70/- per day per head i.e. @ Rs.350/- per head & travel subsidy maximum @ Rs. 550/- per head or actual whichever is less will be reimbursed by the National Headquarters to the participants directly or through the State Association. Please ensure participants to bring their bank account details with them. NOTE: Participants of Railway States are requested to utilize Railway pass accordingly.</p>
<p>Quota</p>	<p>: 3 Rovers, 2 Rangers & 01 Ranger Leader from each state may be deputed. Selection will be made on the basis of "First Come First Serve" (since, the quota is limited, National Headquarters have the right to reject/accept the registration after the completion 100 number of participants).</p>
<p>What to Carry</p>	<p>: INDIVIDUAL KIT: One set of correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part – II/III, Track Suit, Sleeping Bag, Sleeping Mat, Rucksack, Comfortable Sport/Trekking Shoe, Sleeper, Rain-Coat, Jacket, Warm Clothing's, Plate, Mug, Spoon, Writing Materials, Note Book, First-Aid Kit, Lunch Box, P-Cap, Water bottle, torch with extra cell, Personal dress, Traditional Costumes for Camp-Fire and requisite materials for trekking etc. NB: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> . The weather will be very cold due to the onset of winter season. Participants are advised to carry warm clothes and necessary equipment along with them. . Please avoid carrying suitcase or bag. Only Ruck-Sack is preferred. </p>
