Scout Guide Welfare Fund	:	Rs. 2000/- (Two Thousand) per head for Guides/Rangers/Unit Leaders to be paid at the time of Registration.
Financial Assistance	•	National Headquarters will reimburse food subsidy @ <b>Rs. 350/- per</b> <b>head</b> and travel subsidy maximum @ <b>Rs. 550/- per head</b> or actual whichever is less on production of train/Bus ticket subject to receipt of Grant in Aid from the Govt. of India.
