Eligibility

Scouts, Guides, Rovers, and Rangers aged 13 to 17 years, who have completed at least the **Dwitiya Sopan Badge** (for Scouts and Guides) or the Nipun Badge (for Rovers and Rangers), will be led by Adult Leaders at a ratio of 8 participants to 1 leader i.e. 8:1

Formation of Contingent

The usual pattern of formation of Patrol as per APRO will be followed in accordance with Quota allotted.

How to participate

The State Association will send the participation details, based on the quota allotted to them, to the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters via email at jamboree@bsgindia.org, with a copy to the Joint Director of Scouts (Program & Training) at jds@bsgindia.org. The email should include the composition of participants and adult leaders, as per the format provided in Annexure "C".

What to Bring



Judging System

- A panel of judges will evaluate the Group Activities.
 - Grade Certificate with Pennant will be awarded to states achieving a Grade-A in the above activities.
 - The state with the highest score in group activities for each wing will receive the Chief Commissioner's Shield.
 - The state with the highest score in Joint Group Activities will be awarded the Chief National Commissioner's Flag.

Note: Detailed information on the activities will be provided in Jamboree Bulletin No. 2.



Accommodation

One tent will be provided for every 8 Scouts and 1 Adult Leader, and for every 8 Guides and 1 Adult Leader (i.e., one Patrol along with their adult leader).

Additional tents will be provided for the Contingent Leader, State supporting staff, Service Rovers & Rangers, and Quartermaster. As tent availability is limited, no extra tents will be supplied beyond those allocated to each Sub-Camp.

The Jamboree will be divided into two parts:

- Scout Wing
- 2. Guide Wing

Separate accommodations will be provided for Scouts and Guides in their respective camps. We assure adequate water supply and sanitation facilities throughout the Jamboree.

Food Arrangement

: A designated kitchen area will be provided for cooking in each Sub-Camp. We encourage the Scouts and Guides wings to cook and dine separately. In the case of joint cooking, the State must inform the Jamboree Organizer by email at jamboree@bsgindia.org, with a copy to the Joint Director of Scouts (Program & Training) at jds@bsgindia.org, no later than 30.11.2024.

Facilities

- : (i) A bank will be operational at the Jamboree site.
 - (ii) A well-equipped hospital, staffed with qualified doctors, nurses, and dispensary facilities, will be available on-site. 24/7 ambulance services will also be provided. Contingents are requested to bring their own First Aid supplies to address the needs of their members during the journey.
 - (iii) A store will be set up at the Jamboree site, supplying gas cylinders, firewood, groceries, vegetables, milk, dairy products, and other essentials.
 - (iv) An Internet Café will be available in the Sub-Camps.

Transport

Local transportation will be provided free of charge by the Tamil Nadu State Bharat Scouts and Guides from Tiruchchirappalli Junction Railway Station (TPJ) and Bus Station to the Jamboree site starting from 26th January 2025. The distance from these locations to the Jamboree site is approximately 35 km.

Details regarding the rates/charges for tempo and truck services will be communicated shortly.




Sight Seeing
