The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters in collaboration with the Ministry of External Affairs-BIMSTEC Division, is honoured to host the **BIMSTEC "Youth Led Action on Climate Change SEWOCON"** (Seminar Workshop Conference) with the Theme Youth-Led Action on Climate Change.

This event is an initiative to foster climate action and youth empowerment across BIMSTEC nations, aligning with our commitment to the G20 theme "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth · One Family · One Future."

We invite each State Association to nominate two eligible young people, one male and one female. Your nomination shall be completed on the google form <https://forms.gle/K1xWJC2RZpDCaRfC6> and submitted latest by **15 December 2024**.

As you will note from the attached brochure, this is an International Event and therefore, there are a limited number of participants to be representing the Bharat Scouts and Guides in this SEWOCON. Thus, a panel will scrutinize all the nominations received within the cut-out date of 15 December 2024 and select the most eligible candidates. The selection will be based on the following criteria:

1. Age: Must be between 18-25 years (should have completed 18 years of age and shall not be over 25 years of age on 19 Feb 2025)
2. Years of Service in BSG: Number of years as a member
3. Scouting/Guiding Qualification: Rover/Ranger Section Youth Program stage accomplished ([Pravesh](#), [Nipun](#), [Rajya Puruskar](#), [Rashtrapati Puruskar](#))
4. Knowledge and Past work in the area of Climate Change: The work done in the area of climate change by individuals or as part of a team.
