The selected candidate will also have to bear his local transport cost from home station to Delhi and back.
		Since, this is sponsored programme, selection of candidate will be considered on 'First come first serve basis 'Merit. If required, online interview will be called by the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters.

Who can attend	:	Aged 18-25 years old (Preference will be given to President Awardees) (should be born between February 8, 2000, and February 8, 2007) Candidates not coming under this age need not apply.
Accommodation	:	 Participants will stay in tents provided by the Gathering organizers. Each participant must bring their own sleeping bag and mat.

What to carry	:	 Each candidate is required to carry the following: Scout Uniform as per APRO Part - II Each participant must carry two (02) national flags measuring 80×120 cm to be handed over to the Gathering management upon arrival. MP3 of National Song Printed materials highlighting cultural landmarks, country's heritage, tourism, and scouting initiatives for exhibition. Samples of traditional foods. Folklore or traditional performances accompanied by national music. National and scouting souvenirs. Toiletry Kit, Personal Medicines if any
Safe from Harm	:	Participants must complete a "Safe from Harm" training and attach his certificate of completion with their registration form.
Weather	:	 During the gathering, the weather will be sunny during the day and cool at night, with expected temperatures ranging from 16°C to 24°C. Since the camping site is in an open area, participants must bring warm clothing, especially for night time (e.g., padded jackets and heavy trousers). Rain showers may occur during the gathering, so participants should bring a rain jacket.
Travel and VISA arrangements		Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements if selected by NHQ .
		The Emirates Scout Association will handle the issuance of entry visas to the United Arab Emirates for all members participating in the gathering, free of charge, in

 accordance with the country's regulations. The following conditions must be met: Passports must be valid until at least October 1, 2025. Passport copies must be clear and complete, and personal photos must be sized 4×6 cm with a white background.
 Photos must be scanned using a scanner; mobile phone images will not be accepted

State Association is requested to immediately recommend the names of the interested participant as per the eligibility criteria and forward the application to NHQ along with caution money and photopage of valid passport so as to reach NHQ, New Delhi by **06th January, 2025** (late receipt of application will not be accepted) for further processing.
