Scout/Guide Welfare Fund	:	<b>Rs. 350/-</b> per head is to be deposited during registration as a Scout/Guide Welfare Fund.
Financial Assistance	:	<b>Food and lodging</b> will be taken care of by NHQ. <b>2<sup>nd</sup> Sleeper Class train fare</b> and <b>local conveyance</b> will be provided by NHQ on the production of the original tickets with TE Bill.
Promotional Materials	:	Event promotional materials will be provided to the registered participants;
What to bring	:	Two sets of correct and complete uniforms as per APRO-II/III. Laptop, personal requisites, regular medicine (if any) etc.
