SUB: NOTIFICATION- SLIGHT MODIFICATION IN THE SCHEME OF TRAINING (SCOUT WING AND GUIDE WING) OF THE BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES ... REGARDING

Dear Sir/Madam,

The National Council of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, in its meeting held on **30/11/2024** has approved slight modifications and amendments in the Scheme of Training (Scout Wing and Guide Wing) of the Bharat Scouts and Guides. These amendments are applicable across the Association with immediate effect. The details of the changes are as follows:

A. Scheme of Training (Scout Wing)

Description	Existing Rules	Modification in Rules
Chapter-III Training of Trainers Rule No. 6.A (d) (iii) (6) Course for Assistant Leader Trainers:	Must have the experience of at least one year after the completion of Pre-ALT Course successfully and run the Unit effectively. A certificate to this effect is to be submitted along with application for the course.	Must have the experience of at least six months after receiving the HWB Parchment and run the Unit effectively. A certificate to this effect is to be submitted along with application for the course.
Chapter-III Training of Trainers Rule No. 6.A (e) (iii) (2) Course for Leader Trainers:	Must have given at least two years of satisfactory service as an Assistant Leader Trainer.	Must have given at least one year of satisfactory service as an Assistant Leader Trainer.
Note:- It is with an aim to increase the Training Team in the respective State Association. This consideration is exempted only for duration of two years i.e. 30.11.2026 and should not be considered a precedent for future amendments.		
Chapter-III Training of Trainers Rule No. 6.A (c) (iii) (3) Course for Pre-ALTs:	Have completed at least six months after receiving the HWB Parchment.	The existing requirement of undergoing the Pre-ALT Course is withdrawn.

B. Scheme of Training (Guide Wing)

Description	Existing Rules	Modification in Rules
Chapter-III Training of Trainers Rule No. 8.A (d) (iii) (6) Course for Assistant Leader Trainers:	Must have the experience of at least one year after the completion of Pre-ALT Course successfully and run the Unit effectively. A certificate to this effect is to be submitted along with application for the course.	Must have the experience of at least six months after receiving the HWB Parchment and run the Unit effectively. A certificate to this effect is to be submitted along with application for the course.
Chapter-III Training of Trainers Rule No. 8.A (e) (iii) (2) Course for Leader Trainers:	Have given a period of at least two years of satisfactory service as an Assistant Leader Trainer.	Have given a period of at least one year of satisfactory service as an Assistant Leader Trainer.

Note:- It is with an aim to increase the Training Team in the respective State Association. This consideration is exempted only for duration of two years i.e. 30.11.2026 and should not be considered a precedent for future amendments.		
Chapter-III Training of Trainers Rule No. 8.A (c) (iii) (3) Course for Pre-ALTs:	Have completed at least six months after receiving the HWB Parchment.	The existing requirement of undergoing the Pre-ALT Course is withdrawn.
Chapter-II Training of Unit Leaders Rule No. 6 (v) (c) Himalaya Wood Badge Course	A Guider should have at least Two Swarna Pankh Bulbuls/ Four Tritiya Sopan Guides / Two Rajya Puraskar Rangers as the case may be to her credit and submit a certificate from District Organising Commissioner (G) / District Training Commissioner (G)	A Guider should have at least Two Swarna Pankh Bulbuls/ Four Tritiya Sopan Guides/ Two Nipun Rangers as the case may be to her credit and submit a certificate from District Organising Commissioner (G)/District Training Commissioner (G).
Chapter-IV The Training Team Rule No. 11 (ii)	The Honourable Charges issued to Leader Trainers and Assistant Leader Trainers are valid for four years from the date of issue.	The Honourable Charges issued to Leader Trainers and Assistant Leader Trainers are valid for five years from the date of issue.
Note: Candidates from both wings who have already completed the Pre-ALT Course are eligible to attend the ALT Course upon successfully meeting the required criteria.
