Without State Headquarters’ deputation letter, no candidate will be admitted. Note: BSG UID is Mandatory.
Quota	: Rovers – 10, Rangers – 10, Young Unit Leader – 05 Total = 25
What to Bring	: Following materials are to be carried by each participant: Two sets of correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part II / III, Track suit, personal clothing's, Sleeping Bag, Sleeping mat, Toilet requisites, Torch, Water Bottle, Rope, Plate, Mug, Spoon, Writing materials, First Aid kit, Note Book & Pen etc. Short presentation on action taken in SDGs.
