The event focused in developing leaders in National Scout Organisations (NSOs) in implementing the World Safe from Harm Policy at Global, Regional and National events, aiming to enhance the policy's educational framework and improve compliance.

Venue	:	Bangkok Scout Camp (Pisalyabut), located at 100 Soi Saranakhom 5, Si Kan, Don Mueang, Bangkok 10210, Thailand. The camp is 4.4 km away from Don Mueang International Airport (DMK), and it will take approximately ten minutes by car.
Registration Fee	:	USD250.00 covers inland transport (only from the airport to the venue and return), meals (from dinner on 31 March to lunch on 04 April), accommodation during the event (check-in on 31 March and check-out on 04 April, in shared accommodation), and workshop materials.
Who can attend	:	Key Commissioners or Volunteers at any level of the NSO and full time executives responsible for Youth Programmes, Adults in Scouting, Safe from Harm or Child Protection
