Financial Assistance	:	National Headquarters will reimburse food subsidy Rs. 350/- per head and travel subsidy maximum Rs. 550/- per head or actual, whichever is less, on production of train/Bus ticket, subject to receipt of Grant in Aid from the Govt. of India.

Last date of submission	:	All the State Associations are requested to nominate a suitable candidate and forward the list to NHQ by 21.04.2025. Candidates should direct to register at https://bsgevents.in/ and the State Association to approve the registered candidates for the Capacity Building Workshop for Regional Media Correspondent (RMC) and State Media Correspondent (SMC) by 21st April 2025 . No candidate will be allowed in the workshop without registration on the portal.
Special Note	:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The state may recommend the name of a new or existing RMCs/SMCs 2. A state-level selection process can be conducted before nominating candidates, as their primary responsibility will be to highlight state activities in the National/State Magazine, Social Media, BSG News, and various state and national media/publication houses. 3. Selected candidates will be trained to manage State Social Media and News. They can also develop skills in conducting interviews and preparing reports on state-level events. 4. They will receive training to effectively coordinate with district media coordinators. 5. States should review the previous year's performance of existing SMCs in showcasing their activities on various social media platforms before selection. 6. NHQ will prioritize inviting SMCs and RMCs to join the media team for Jamborees, various mega events etc.

State Associations are requested to encourage interested and eligible candidates to submit their applications through the event portal for these opportunities.
